THE WINE:

100% Zinfandel from the Hambrecht clone, known for its unique flavors and bright acidity. Hand-picked and hand sorted. Cold soaked then gently pressed before fermentation. Total production for 2007 vintage was less than 1,000 cases. Winemaker Marco Cappelli, known as a Zinfandel and Rhone specialist made this wine.

THE ESTATE:

Sierra Moon Vineyards opened in 2000 as the result of a lifelong passion for great wine and food. Owners EJ and Chiyo Edminster bought a small vineyard in the Sierra Foothills. They spend most of their days in the vineyard, carefully growing the very best quality fruit the land can provide. The limited production winery produces about 5,000 cases per year all from the tiny Fair Play AVA. Three white Rhone varietals (Viognier, Marsanne, Rousanne), Two red Rhone (Petite Syrah, Syrah) and Red Zinfandel are planted on the estate.

~Tasting Notes~

Color: Dark garnet with flashes of violet.

Aromas. Blackberry, sweet raspberry, spice and tea. Notes of cinnamon and hints of chocolate.

Flavors. Ripe berries and sweet jasmine tea notes coat the palate with toasted vanilla and whispers of white pepper.

Food Pairing. BBQ rack of ribs with a sweet hickory sauce.
