

2020 Mai Soli Zinfandel

Dry Creek AVA, Sonoma, California



The Wine:

A classic Dry Creek Sonoma Zinfandel produced by one of Zinfandel's true pioneers. The wine is 100% Zinfandel from older vines (up to 45 years old), grown on the hillsides above Geyserville in California's most famous Zinfandel producing region. Only 110 cases were made. The grapes were handpicked from these head-trained Zinfandel vines and barrel aged in French and American oak for 24 months.

The Project:

Made by Joe Ramazzotti, these wines bring together the old-world traditions of Italian winemakers and the classic new world style of Zinfandel. Joe and his wife Norma run Ramazzotti Winery in Geyserville, CA which was established in 2002. Joe has been growing Zinfandel grapes for over 50 years in Dry Creek after immigrating to the US from Italy at seven years old. Joe has earned the reputation as one of the world's best farmers of the Zinfandel grape and with access to over 5,000 acres of Zinfandel vines throughout California he has selected his favorite parcels for the production of these wines.

Tasting Notes:

Color: Dark maroon red.

Aromas: Ripe black cherry, berries, vanilla bean and hints of white pepper.

Flavor & Texture: Sweet black and red fruit and subtle spice, and toasted oak. The mouthfeel is soft and creamy with classic mild Zinfandel tannins.

Food Pairing: Gourmet burgers hot off the grill.
