- 1 3.00" x 3.50" Silicone Coupler
- 1 3.50" Silicone Coupler
- 1 30" Ground Wire
- 1 Intake Manifold Gasket

Please check your parts inventory against the above parts list before beginning your installation.

### **Arctic-Heat Grid Heater Installation**

- 1. Disconnect the battery negative cables.
- 2. Remove the charge air cooler tube connection from the intake manifold.
- 3. Remove the engine oil dipstick tube mounting bolt.
- 4. Remove the engine wiring harness support bolt from the intake manifold.
- 5. Remove the six (6) intake manifold mounting bolts.
- 6. Remove the intake manifold.
- 7. Remove the charge air cooler tube connection from the intercooler outlet.
- 8. Remove the stock charge air cooler tube from the vehicle.
- 9. Disconnect the stock grid heater power cable at the cable mounting stud on the intake plenum.

### Assembling the Arctic-Heat Grid Heater

Refer to photo 1 for orientation in the following steps.

- 10. **Loosely** assemble the unit as shown in photo 1.
- 11. Finger tighten the bolts evenly.
- 12. Using a criss-cross pattern, evenly tighten the bolts and nuts to 25 ft-lbs. Cummins graphite gaskets have very little compression ability.

#### Even tightening is critical for leak free operation

- 13. The ground wire comes pre-installed. If you need to change the orientation of the ground wire loosen the bolt. **DO NOT FULLY REMOVE THIS BOLT.** There are small parts on the inside of the heater which may fall out of the bolt is removed.
- 14. If needed, change the ground wire orientation. Ground wire must be facing the outside of the vehicle when tube is installed.
- 15. Using the supplied 3.00" x 3.50" silicone reducer and clamps loosely attach the boost tube to the intercooler outlet. Do not tighten at this time.
- 16. Route the new ground wire under the fuse box and connect to the battery negative post as shown in photo 2.

- 17. Route the stock grid heater power wire over to the new Arctic-Heat grid heater.
- 18. Connect the stock power wire to the positive post at the top of the Arctic-Heat grid heater and tighten.
- 19. Loosely install the 3.50" straight silicone coupler on the end of the new Arctic-Heat boost tube.
- 20. Install the intake manifold using the supplied gasket.
- 21. Connect the boost tube to the intake manifold using the supplied clamps and tighten.
- 22. Tighten the intercooler to boost tube connection at the intercooler outlet.
- 23. Verify clearance between the new grid heater and the power steering hoses. If needed, flex lines down **gently** to gain clearance.
- 24. Install the engine oil dipstick tube and mounting bolt.
- 25. Attach the engine wire harness to the air inlet housing.
- 26. Connect the battery negative cables.

Installation complete! Enjoy the easy cold weather starting provided by the Arctic-Heat grid heater relocation kit!

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
