

To play the BS Button Game Expansion Pack, follow these steps:

1. **Setup**: Deal the cards equally among all players, and start a discard pile with any extra cards. If playing with two players, it's suggested to use a partial deck to keep things unpredictable. The Expansion Pack can also be combined with the Original BS Button Game for play with 6-12 players. More buttons, more wild cards, more players mean more fun!
2. **Dealer's Turn**: The dealer chooses a card value and discards up to four cards face-down. For example, the dealer may say, "Three 9's" and place three cards in the discard pile.
3. **Gameplay**: Play continues clockwise. Each player must play a card that is the next card higher or lower in sequence to the last one called. For instance, if the last card played was a 9, the next player can play an 8 or a 10.
4. **Bluffing**: If a player doesn't have the appropriate card(s) to play, he must bluff. Any player can call a bluff by pushing the BS Button. The discards are then revealed. If the call is valid (the player was bluffing), all the discarded cards are added to the bluffer's hand. If the call is invalid (the player was telling the truth), all the discarded cards are added to the caller's hand.
5. **Winning**: The first player to discard every card while avoiding a valid call of bluff wins the game.
6. **Activist Cards**: Instead of discarding, a player can play an activist card. They lay one card face-down on the discard pile, name an opponent, and call out any card value. (Activist cards add to the

game's unpredictability. They disrupt the flow and give the player who plays them an upper hand.)

- The opponent must discard one to four cards or call a bluff by pressing the BS Button.
- If the call is valid and the card is an activist, the discarded cards are added to the caller's hand.
- If the call is invalid and the card is not an activist, all the discarded cards are added to the bluffer's hand.
- Play resumes to the left of the opponent, and the card higher or lower in sequence to the last one called is played.

7. **Activist Wild Cards:** Activist cards are wild and can be used to represent any card value.

Remember, an activist card is removed from play once exposed.
