## Original Arch Shade

 Imperfect Arch Guide
## Measure for Imperfect Arch

If page 1 told you have you an imperfect arch, follow these steps:

Determine where to cut, if your height (A) measurement is smaller than the base (B), divide the base in half, and cut the shade on that mark. If the height $(A)$ is larger than half the base (B) measurement, a cut will be made on the height measurement.

Example: A window's base is 50 " and height is $23^{\prime \prime}$. Half of the base is 25 ". Because the height is smaller than half the base, cut at the 25 " mark to ensure there is excess to trace.


## 2 Trace

With the initial cut made, fan the shade open in the window. DO NOT adhere the shade. With a pencil, trace the curvature of the arch on the excess material.

This traced line will allow you to cut off the excess at the top or sides of your shade to make for a perfect fit in your imperfect arch window.

Example: For this window, the height is slightly larger than the base. We would trace the curvature of the top of the window to trim the slight excess at the top of the shade.


## Trim \& Install

Remove the traced shade from the window. Using a pair of sharp scissors, cut along the line you made to remove the excess material.

Once the shade has been trimmed, place the shade in the window to ensure it is properly trimmed. Then, install the shade as shown on page 1 .
