- Keep all loose clothing away from moving parts when the plucker attachment is in use.
- Keep fingers and hair away from moving parts when the plucker attachment is in use.
- To keep supervision is necessary when any appliance is used near children.
- Do not allow children to operate this machine.
- Never remove the unit when it is running.
- Do not disassemble the plucker attachment or place anything in the plucker during Operation
- It must be fix firmly when operate the chicken plucker attachment.
- Feathers will go everywhere during the operation, so you will wear safety glasses.

OPERATIONS

(Take chicken as an example)

1. Install the chicken plucker attachment on a water-proof electric drill (lithium or AC drill), fix it on a stable surface, no shake is very important.
2. Immerse the killed chicken in the 156°F(69°C()) water, soak the chicken around 2 min. (Excessive temperature may burn the skin, but too low temperature has no effect on the feather).
3. Recommend to mix the soap with scald water to make the oil on chicken' feathers easily broken down, which allows the hot water to penetrate to chicken skin.
4. Turn on the electric drill and adjust the speed at 350-400RPM.
5. Wear protective gloves and glasses, keep close the chicken to the rotating drill attachment slowly, rotate the chicken continuously, observe and adjust the chicken constantly, so that all parts of the chicken can be plucked perfectly.

TIPS

1. Suitable for these kinds of birds: chickens, pheasants, and other poultry, not for ducks and geese
2. Use the drill attachment under rated speed and remember that all the stages (slaughter-scalding-defeathering) should be effectuated without breaks or interruptions!
3. If while plucking not all the feather removes, it is necessary to rise the temperature or increase the duration of scalding.
4. If the skin was damaged, it is necessary to decrease the temperature or reduce the time of scalding.
