

Suggested Daily Care Routine

You might find the following guidelines and care tips featured throughout this brochure helpful in the establishment of an effective laryngectomy and management care routine.



1 SKIN CARE
Clean skin around the stoma with mild soap and water and dry.



2 VOICE PROSTHESIS
This needs to be cleaned regularly to maintain function and good quality voice by using voice prosthesis cleaning brushes. Our Voiceline cleaning brush fits all sizes of prosthesis.



3 PROTECTION
Apply Trachi-Wipe skin barrier to protect your skin from secretions – preventing irritation and soreness. Kapi-Gel can protect the stoma behind a stoma button or Laryngectomy tube.

KAPI-GEL
Ideal for difficult stoma anatomy - providing cushioning behind the laryngectomy tube flange/neckplate or stoma stud.



4 COMBINED AIRWAY PROTECTION
Use one of the following products for humidification, filtration and improved respiratory performance:

Buchanan - Lite	Trachi-Naze
Buchanan	Baseplate
Laryngofoam	Stoma Stud

TRACHI-HOLD
Secure tube with Trachi-Hold.



5 ADDITIONAL HUMIDIFICATION
When using an airway protector additional humidification is sometimes required. Trachi-Mist is a simple way to provide a fine saline spray to the stoma.



6 LARYNGECTOMY TUBE CLEANING
Laryngectomy tubes should be cleaned at least on a daily basis to prevent the build up of mucus and keep the tube surfaces clean and ensure good hygiene. Our range of cleaning brushes, solutions and swabs are designed to clean plastic and silicone laryngectomy tubes.



7 STORAGE
