Boats will be required to navigate their way around a predetermined course starting on Pittwater and finishing near Refuge Bay. Boats will be scored on their ability to maintain a constant boat speed and correct heading throughout the event. Maps, event instructions and data recorders are supplied on the day, so why not invite some friends on your boat and enjoy the day. The event will conclude with boats gathering in Refuge Bay where the results will be announced and BYO lunch and drinks consumed.

This event is the third and last event, making up the Cruiser Division Navigational Series.

All boats and navigators accrue points over the three events, with the winners being awarded the prestigious Boat and Navigator of the Year trophies at the annual Gala Event.

This event is free and can easily be undertaken by two people, but the more the merrier. It's about having fun and learning a little more about your boat and basic navigation. All entrants will be provided with all the required information and instructions on the day.
