

Sail East Cruise

SATURDAY 4TH & SUNDAY 5TH MAY



This was the cruise we were planning to share with the Top Hat Division however the Top Hatters have a race scheduled on Saturday and unable to participate.

So the revised plan is for the SCD fleet to rendezvous off the Basin at 10.30am on Saturday and unfurl the sails for a cruise east in a triangle from Palm Beach (Little Head) across to Maitland Bay then up the creek to Jerusalem Bay where we will anchor for the night in about 5 metres. If the weather is amenable we should have a relaxed open waters cruise and may even spot a few whales before a run with the tide up to Jerusalem Bay where I expect that we should arrive at about 2.30pm. Skippers can also go direct to Jerusalem Bay in their own time if they prefer.

Lunch at your leisure. Depending on numbers we will have sundowners on Wings 9 or a bigger boat at 5.00pm then group dinners for those who want to share will be organised on the day.

Morning tea on Sunday then back to home moorings.
