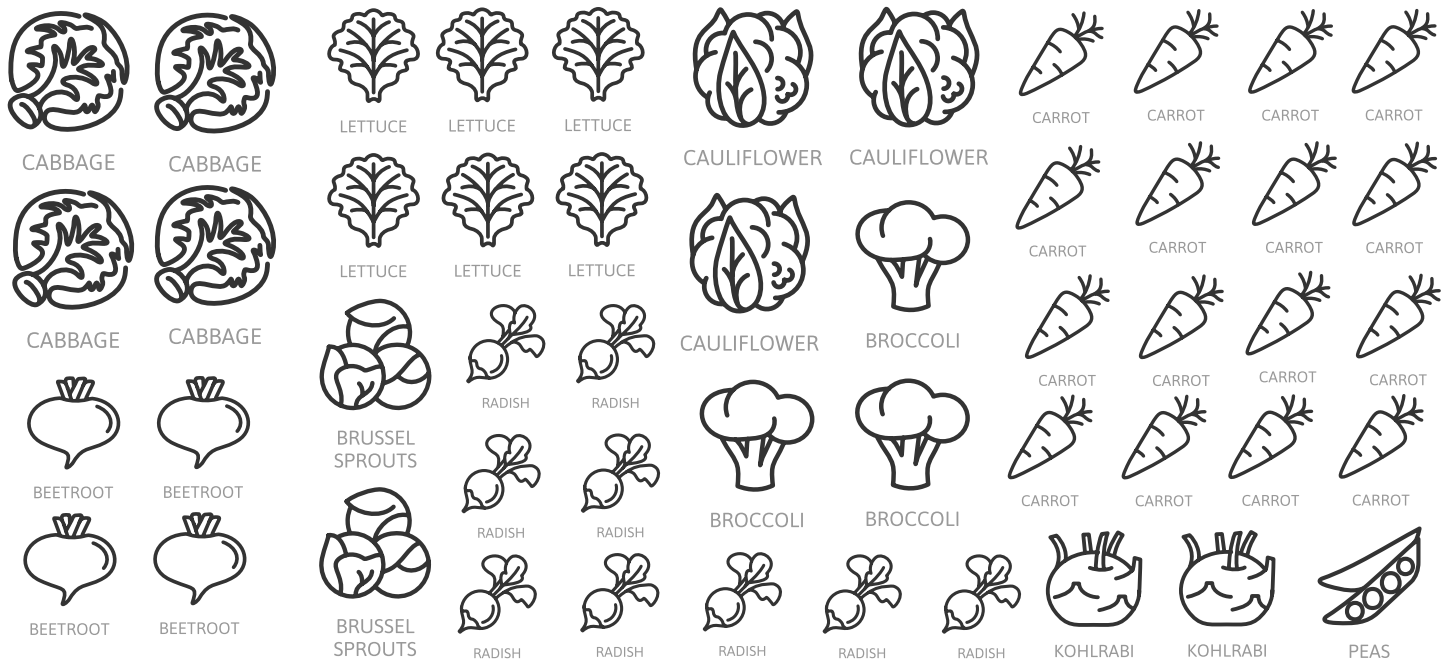


# MAKE FALL SEASON PLANTING PLANS!

= Foes (Crops to Avoid)



<p><b>Carrots</b> </p> <p> brussels sprouts, cabbage, lettuce, peas, onions, radishes</p> <p> celery, dill, turnips, parsnips</p>	<p><b>Cabbage</b> </p> <p> beets, celery, onion, peas, dill</p> <p> lettuce</p>
<p><b>Beets</b> </p> <p> brussels sprouts, cabbage, lettuce, kohlrabi, onions, radishes, spinach</p> <p> turnips, mustard greens</p>	<p><b>Brussels Sprouts</b> </p> <p> beets, carrots, radishes, spinach</p> <p> kohlrabi</p>

# MAKE FALL SEASON PLANTING PLANS!


Steps to get started!

1. Choose one main crop for each garden bed.
2. Pick 2-4 companion plants for the main crops.
3. Keep spacing in mind while planning and placing.
4. Draw some herbs and flowers among the plants.
