03 2.02 Main Duties and Responsibilities

Without being restrictive, and subject to modification (in the latter case, by prior notice from the Employer), the Senior Officer's main duties and responsibilities shall be as follows:

- to execute the duties and to assume the responsibilities normally tied to this position;
- to execute, by delegation, all or part of the powers of the of the Employer, except those that cannot be delegated by law;

2.03 Immediate Supervisor

The Senior Officer shall report directly to, in the position of, or to any other person designated by the Employer.

2.04 Work Place

The Senior Officer's work place shall be located at, or at any other place required for the efficient operation of the Employer's business.

During the entire term of this Agreement, the Senior Officer shall hold a valid driver's license and shall be in a position to use his vehicle for work.

3.01 Salary
