


Tundra - Transfer Case Plate

Be sure to use lubrication on all stainless steel nuts & bolts to prevent galling.



■1. If Transmission rear bolts are not loose from install, loosen transmission rear bolts and install the square spacers above the transmission plate.



■2. Mount Z brackets to frame. There will be a square hole about 18" from the transfer case cross member. Use this hole to mount the Z bracket.

■3. If this is a 4x4 truck, remove factory transfer case shield.



 4. Slide transfer case plate above transmission plate.
Ensure square spacers are above transfer case skid next to frame.

■5. Attach Z brackets to ½" holes on the rear of the transfer case plate.



•• 6. At this point, if you are installing the transfer case plate with the transmission plate, tighten all bolts starting from the front bolt and working your way forward.
