

Viking Incognito Solo Saddlebag Installation for Royal Enfield Interceptor /Continental 650:



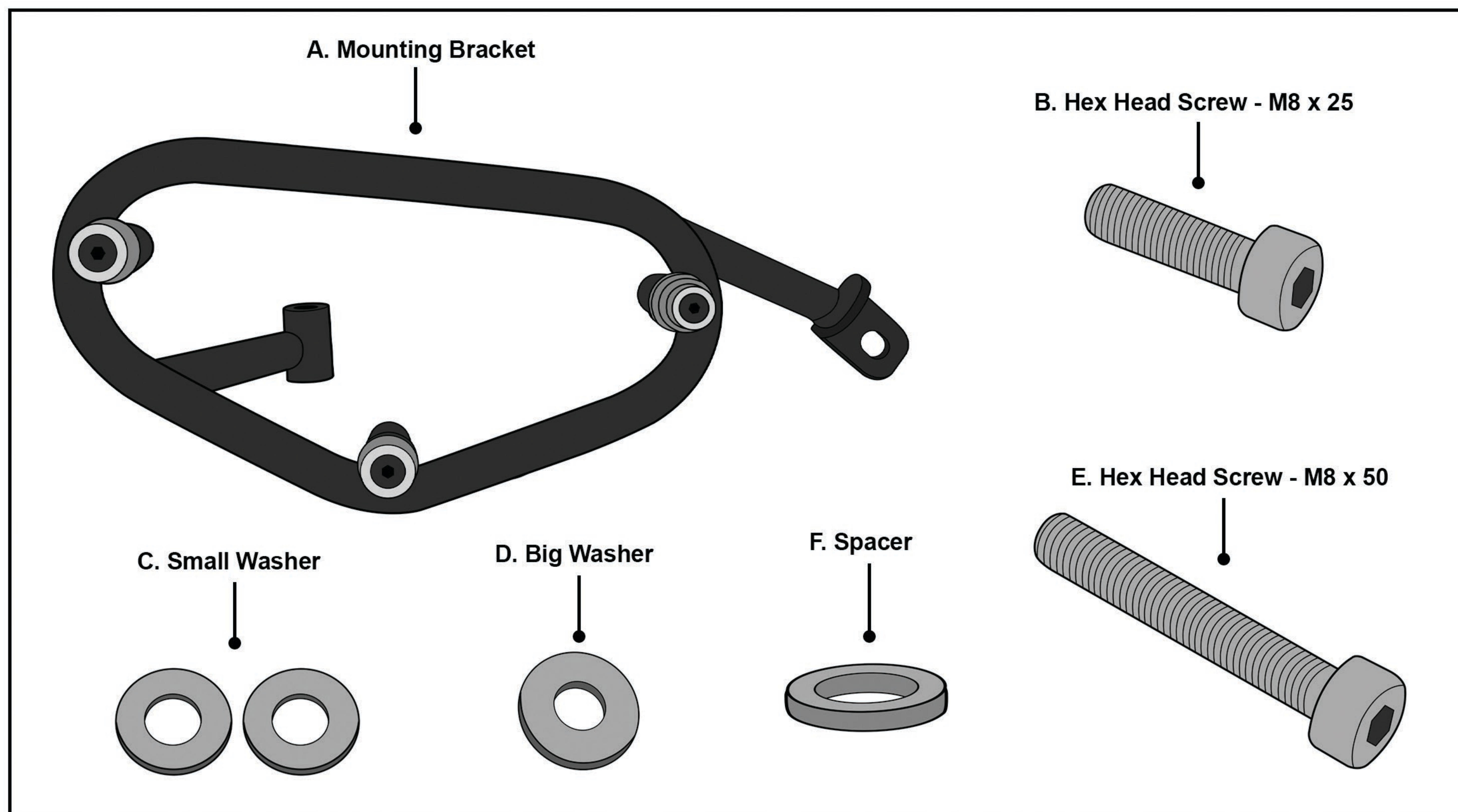
Parts List:

A	Mounting Bracket	x1
B	Hex Head Screw - M8 x 25	x1
C	Small Washer	x2
D	Big Washer	x1
E	Hex Head Screw - M8 x 50	x1
F	Spacer	x1

Note:

- Tighten screws with the manufacturer's specified torque.
- Make sure to use Loctite for the final step.

Installation Instructions:

Note: Move to Step 2 if you don't have a passenger grab rail.

Step 1:

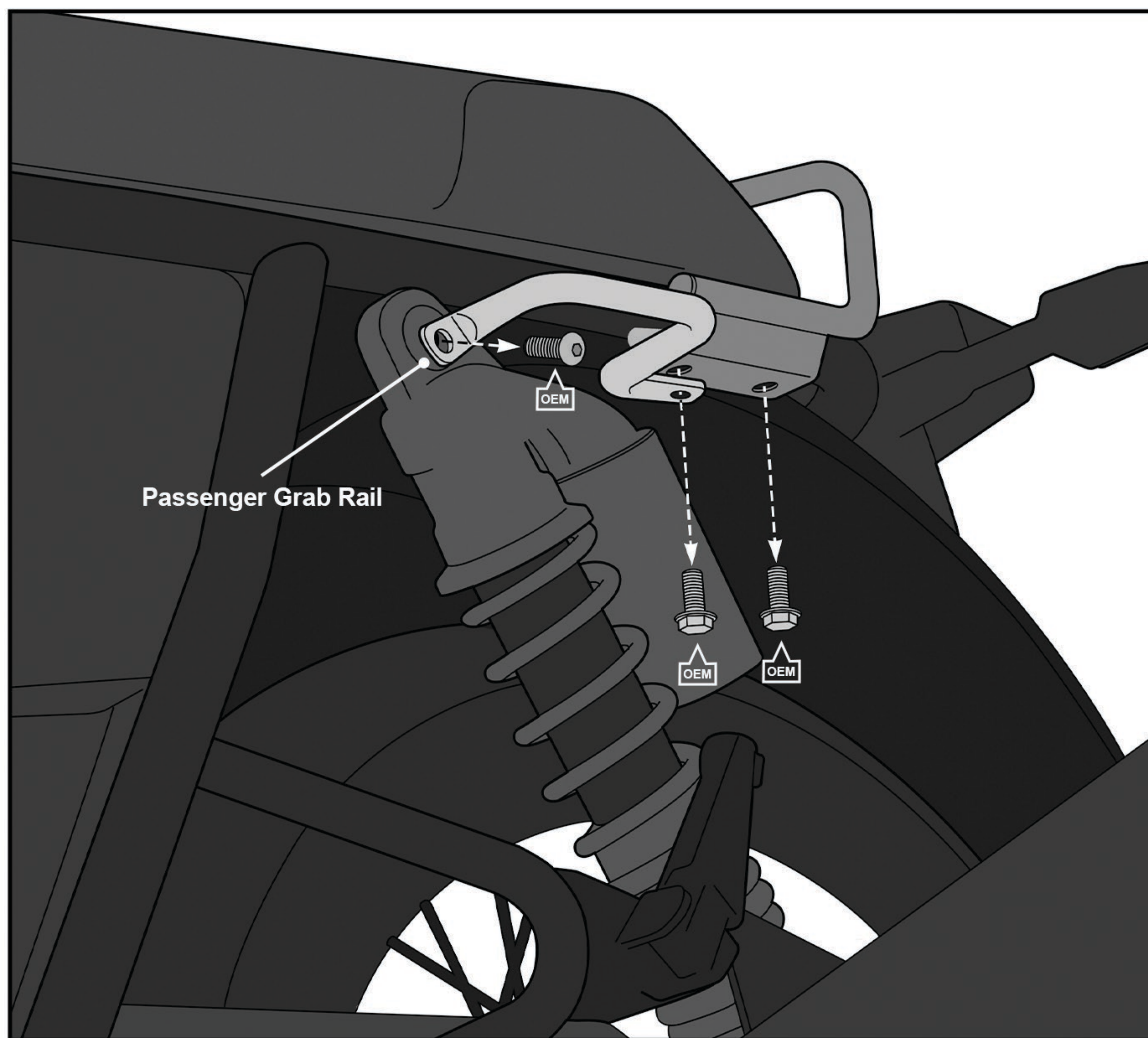


Fig 1. Remove OEM bolts and passenger grip

Remove two OEM bolts and the motorcycle passenger grip. Refer to Fig 1.

Step 2:

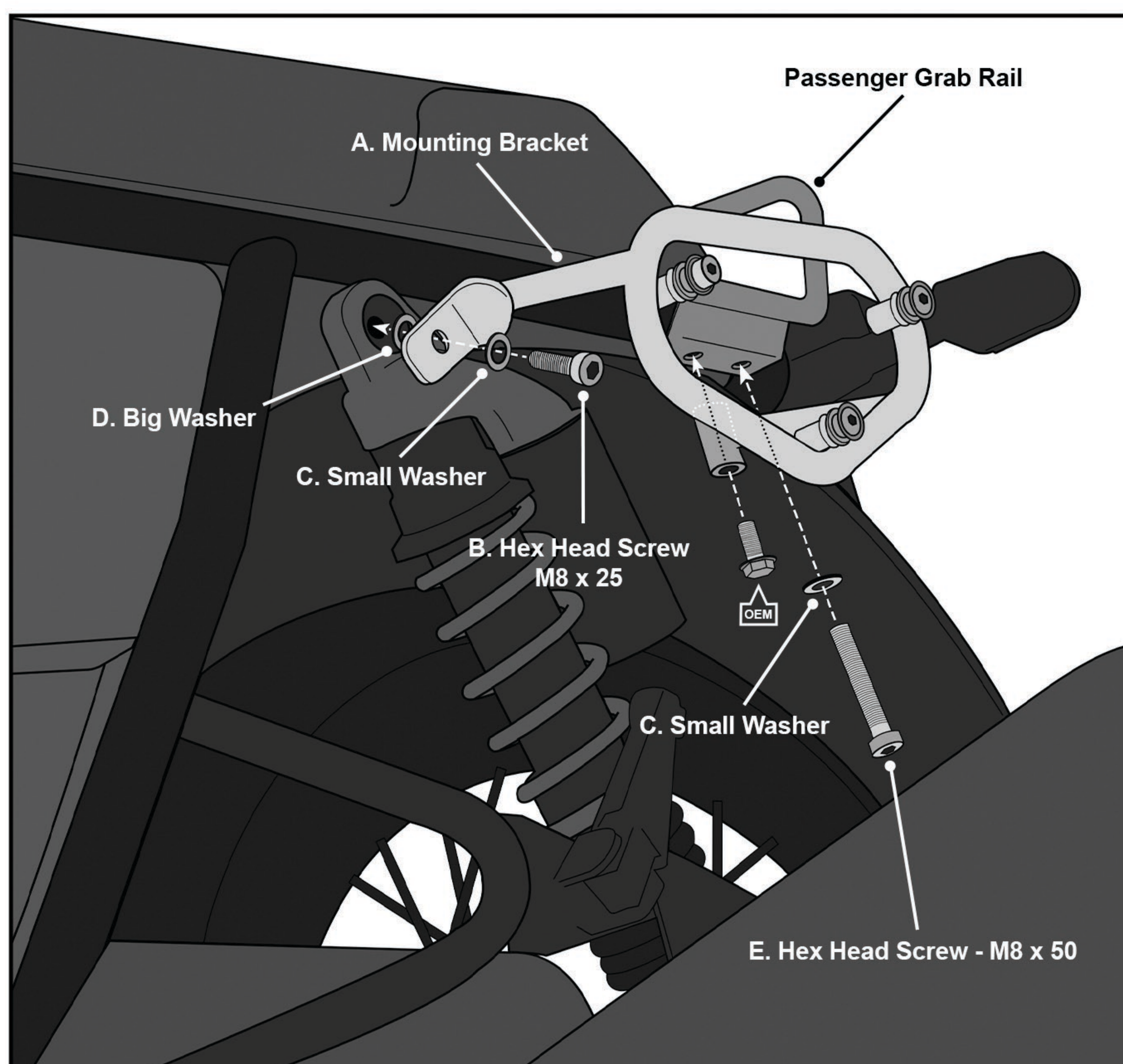


Fig 2. Attaching the Mounting Bracket

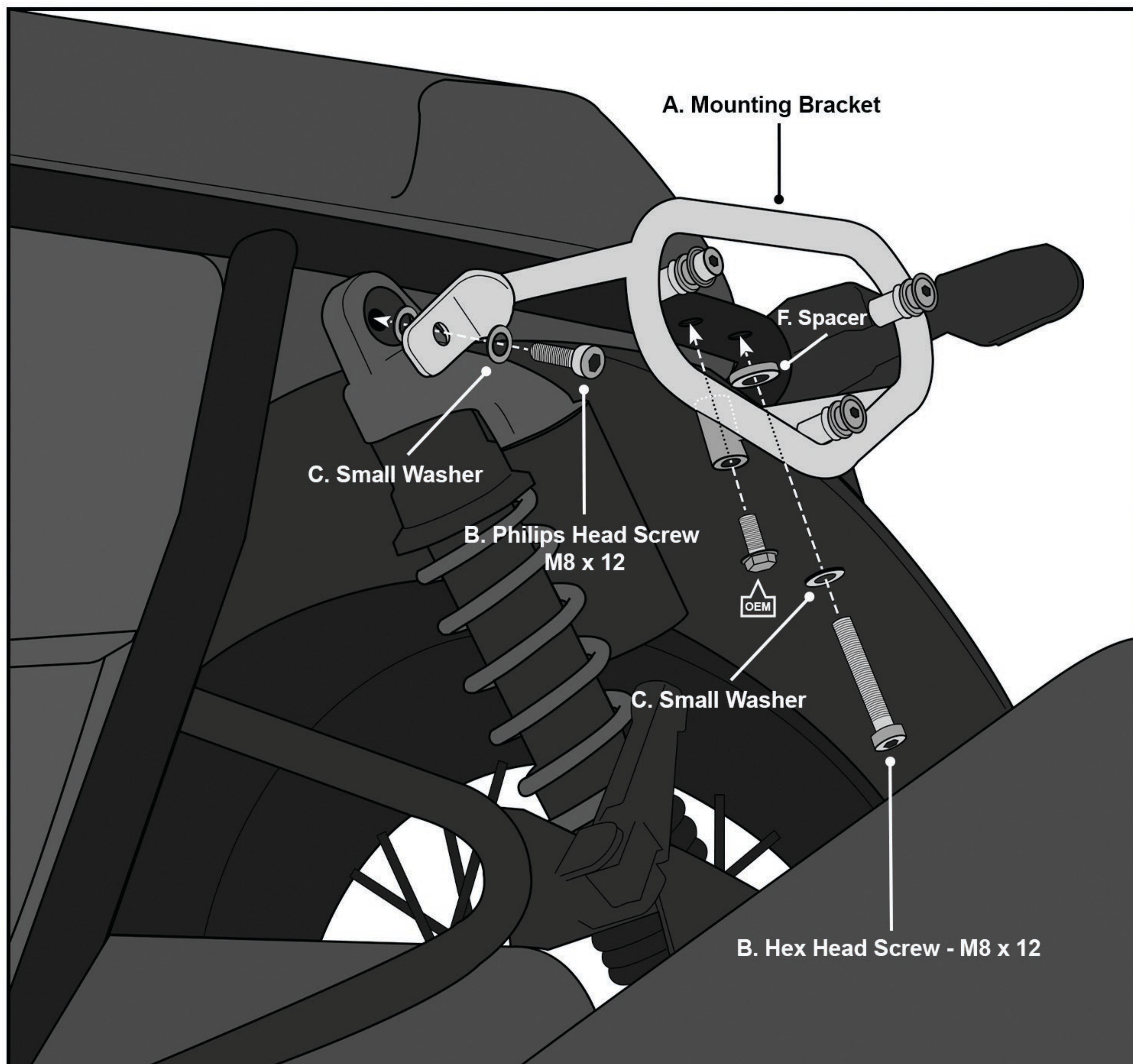


Fig 3. Attaching the mounting bracket without passenger grab rail

Note: Refer to Fig 2. If you have a passenger grab rail. Refer to Fig 3. If you do not have a passenger grab rail.

If you have a passenger grab rail, attach the mounting bracket(A) using the OEM Screw, Hex Head Screw - M8 x 25(B), and Hex Head Screw - M8 x 50. Refer to Fig 2.

If you do not have a passenger grab rail, attach the mounting bracket(A) using the OEM Screw, Hex Head Screw - M8 x 25(B), and Hex Head Screw - M8 x 50. Refer to Fig 3.

Step 4:

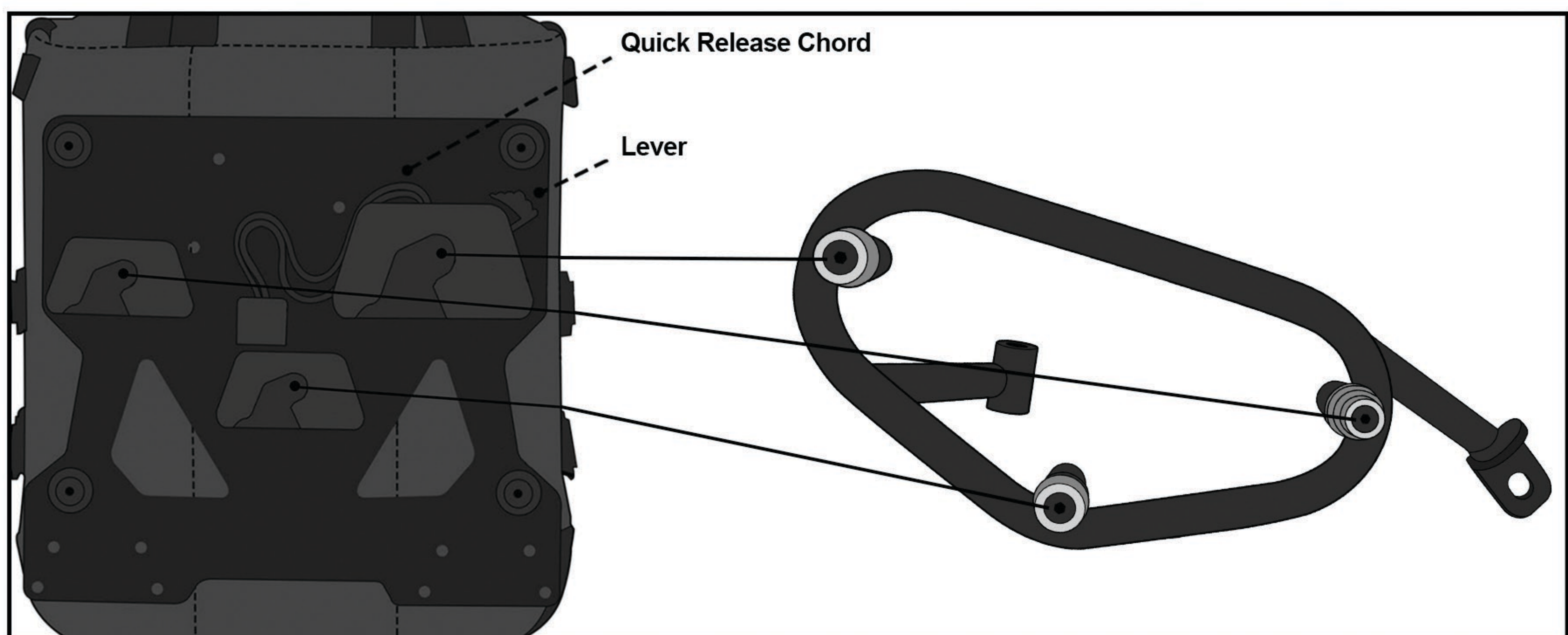
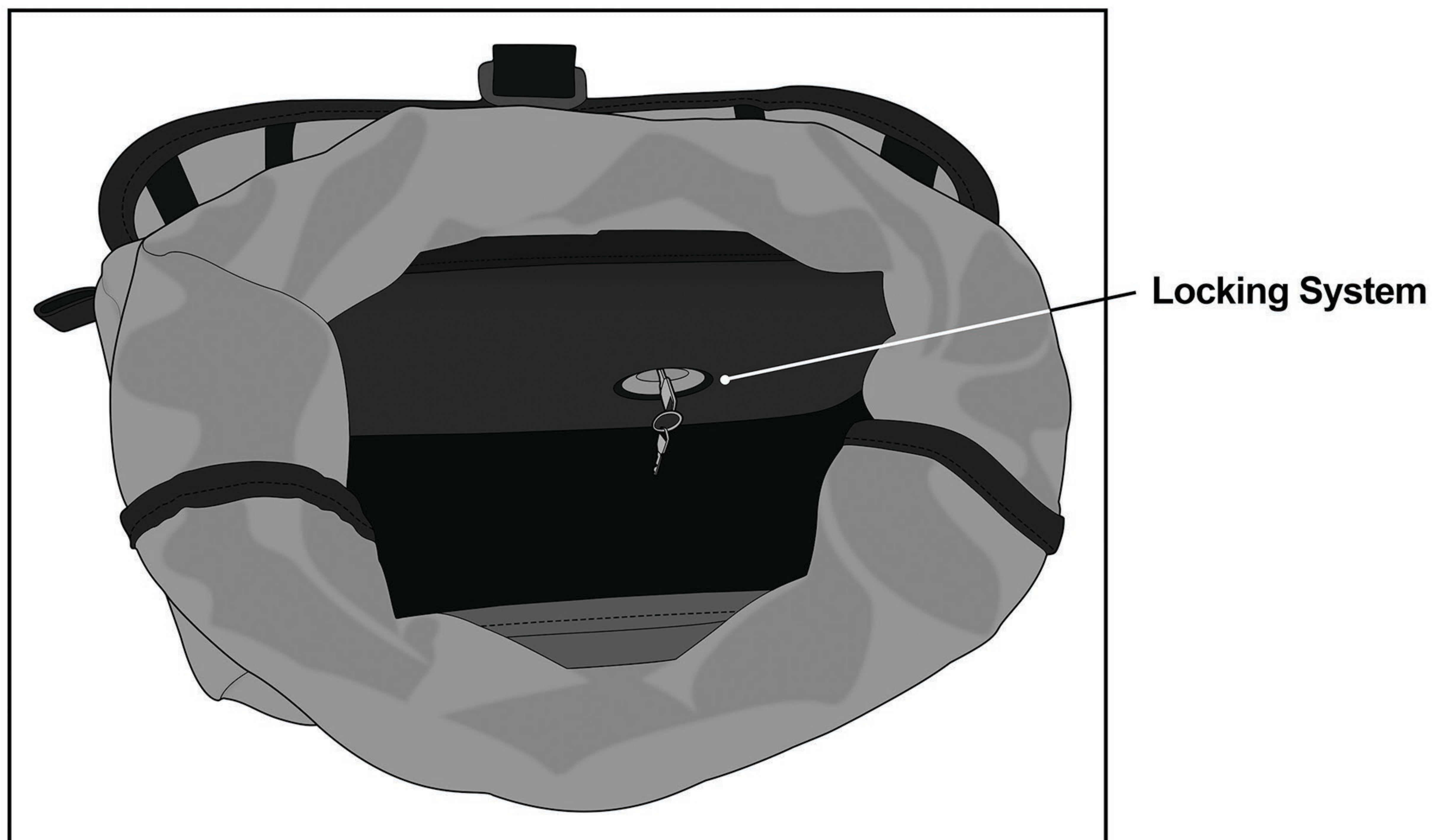


Fig 4. Attaching the bag to the bracket

Use the pre-installed adapter plate in the back of the Viking Detachable Solo Bag to mount it on the bracket as shown in Fig 4. Press the Solo Bag onto the mounting pegs until it properly rests on the mounting bracket.

To release the bag, press the lever or pull the quick-release cord.

Tip:

The quick disconnect system is key lockable. Lock / unlock the quick disconnect system from inside the bag to secure your bag against theft.
