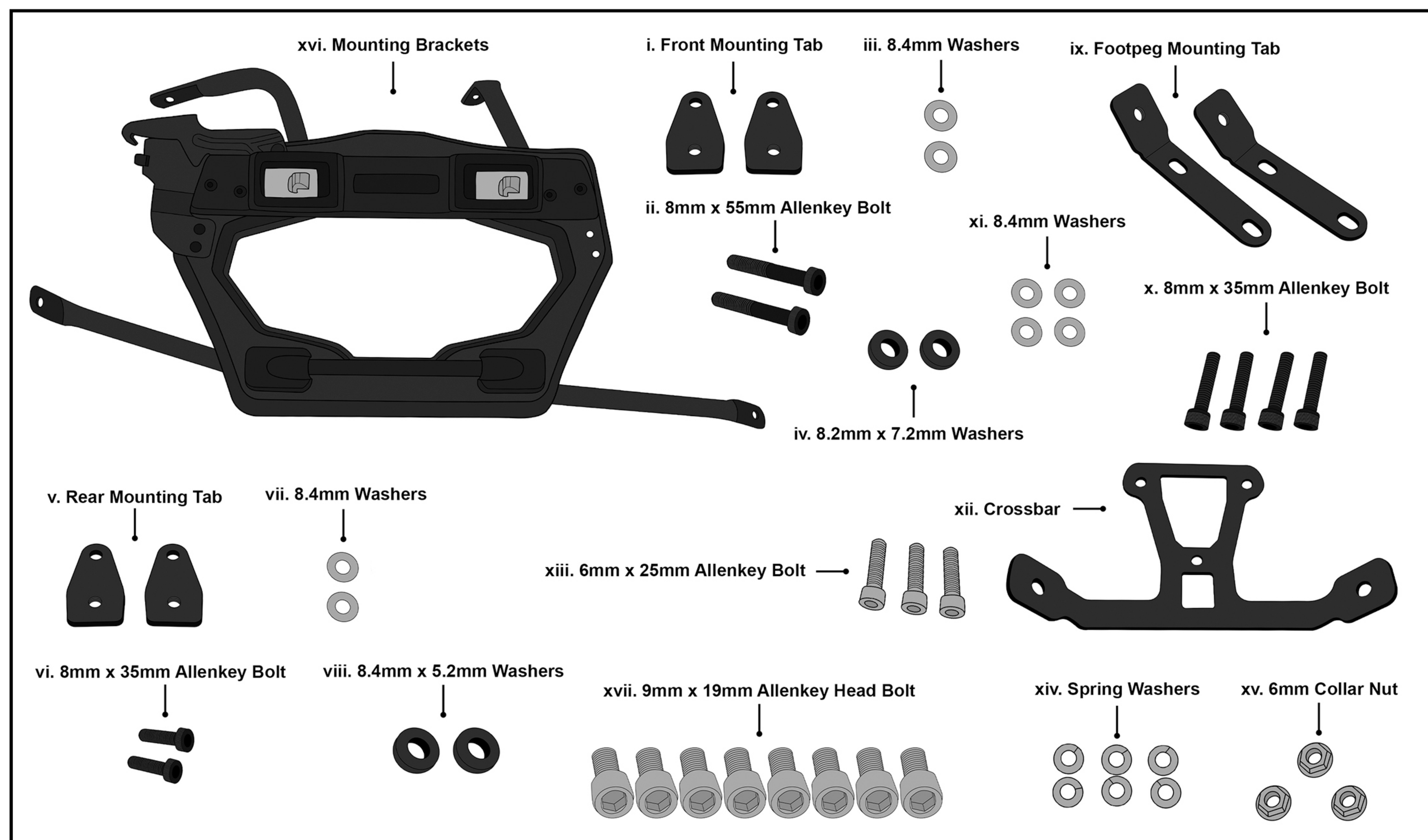
Tools Needed:

- i Hex Driver Set
- ii Thread Locktite
- iii Wrench

Tip:

- i Apply Loctite to ensure proper installation of bolts.
- ii Read the installation instructions carefully and make sure that all parts under the parts list are included.

Instructions:

Step 1:

Remove the motorcycle seat, and passenger footpeg mounts from both sides of the bike, and the three screws from the license plate.

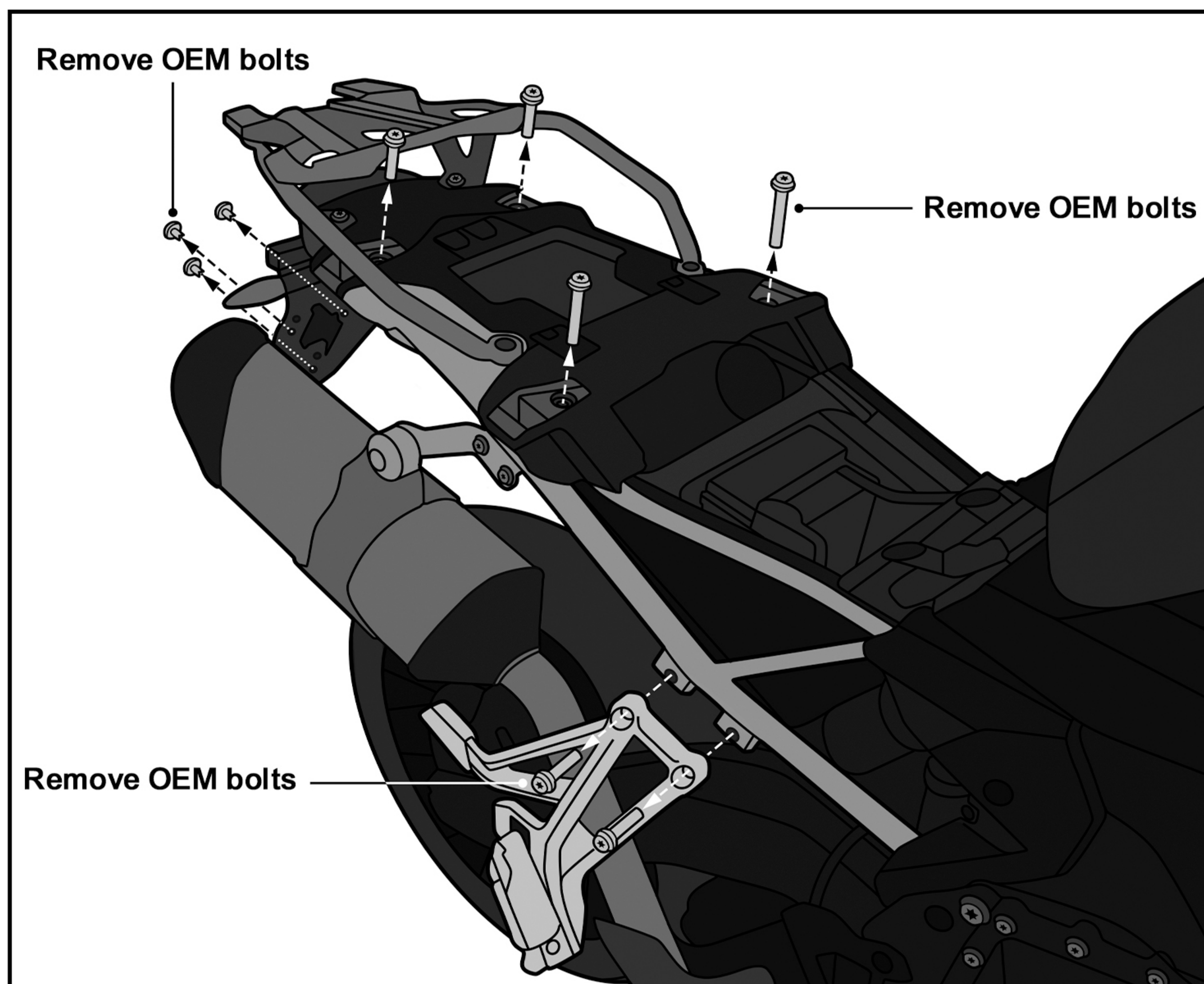


Fig 2. Removing all OEM bolts

See Fig 2.

Step 2:

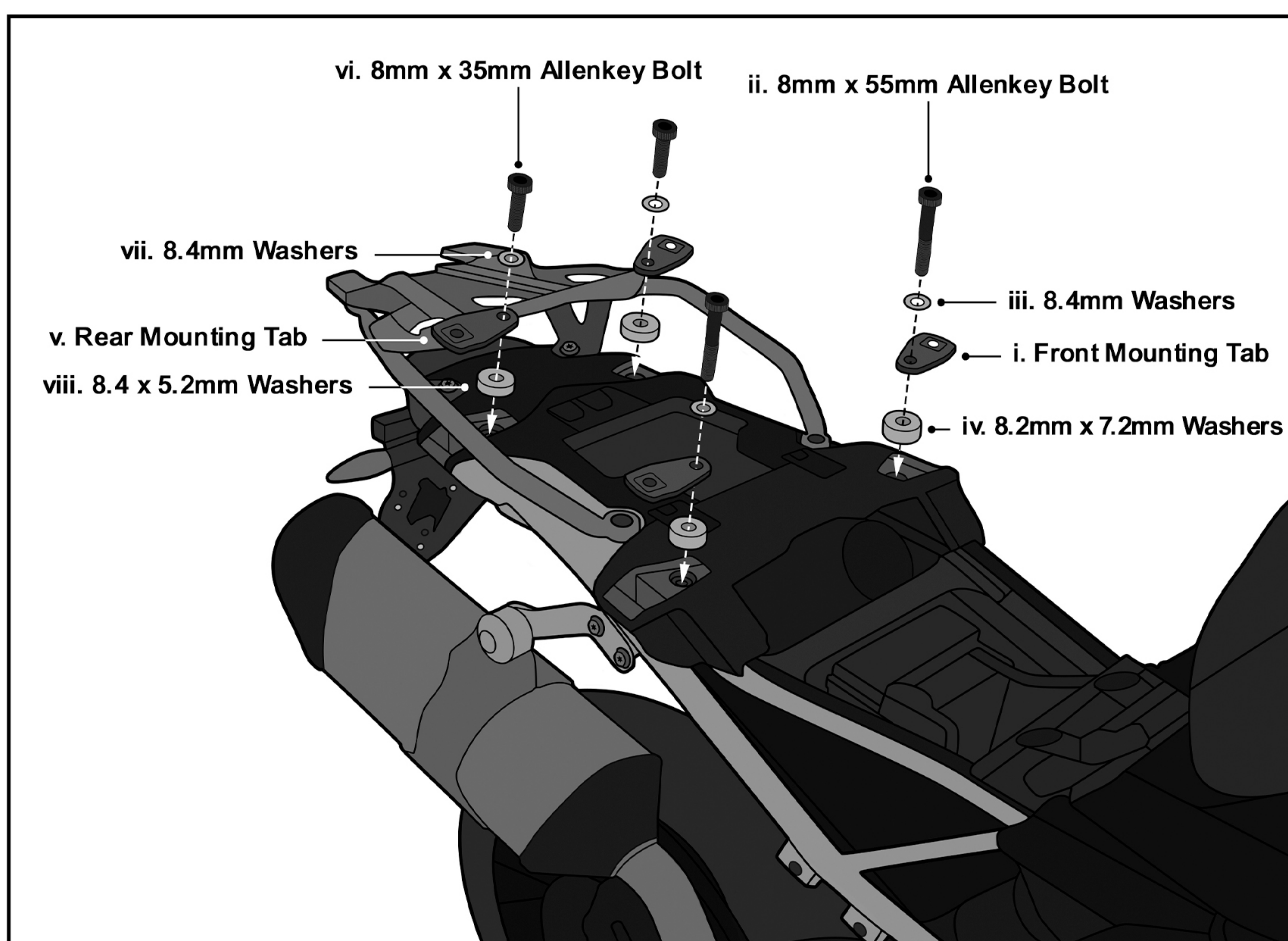


Fig 3. Installing the mounting tabs

Install the front mounting tab (I) and rear mounting tab. See Fig 3.

Step 3:

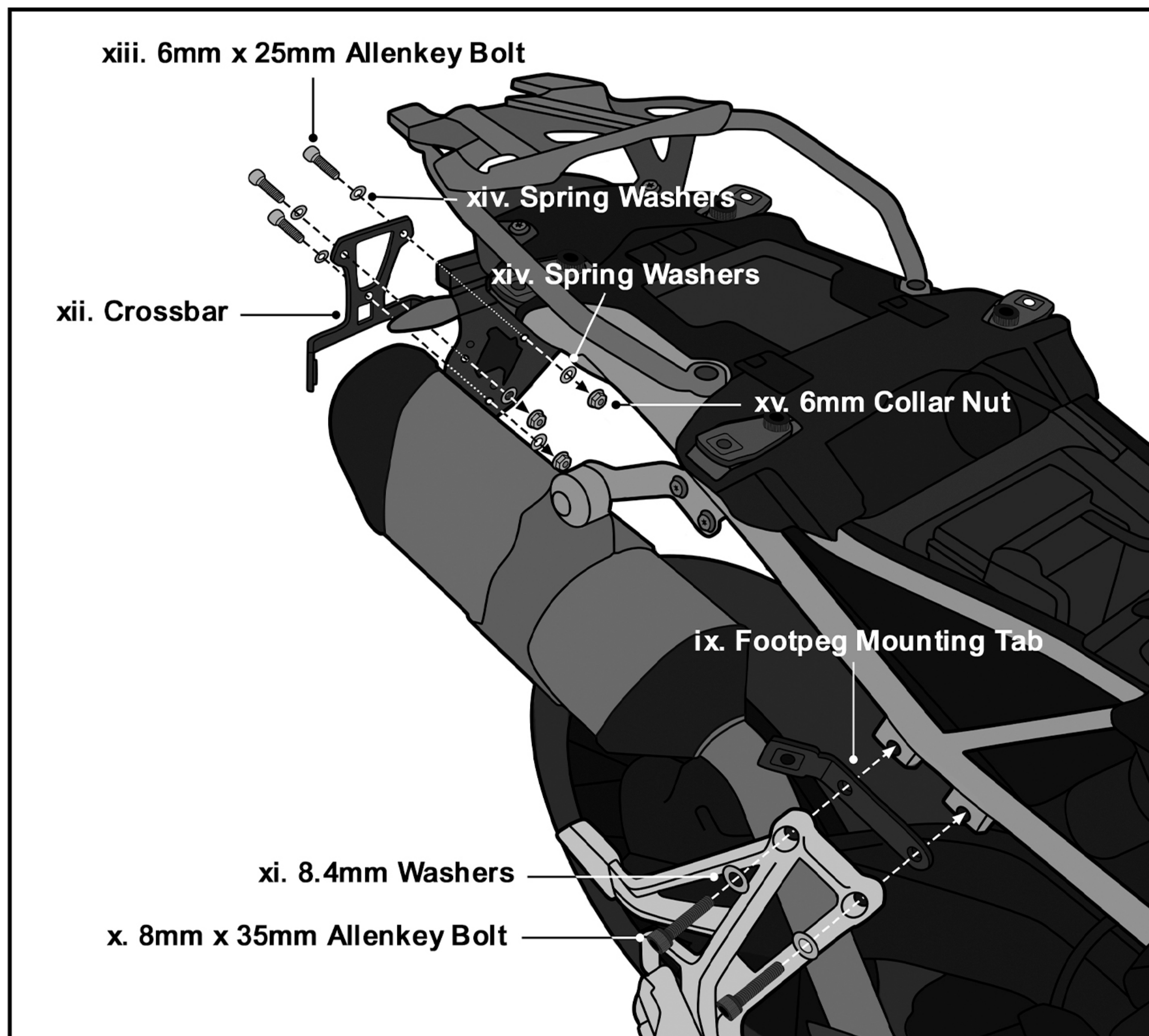


Fig 4. Installing the footpeg mounting tabs and the crossmember

Install the footpeg mounting tabs on both sides of the bike (IX.) and crossmember (XII.) to the motorcycle license plate holder. (See Fig 4.)

Step 4:

Attach the mounting brackets (XVI) to the front and rear mounting tabs (I, V), footpeg mounting tabs (IX), and crossmember (XII) using the provided 9mm x 19mm Allenkey head bolts (XVII)

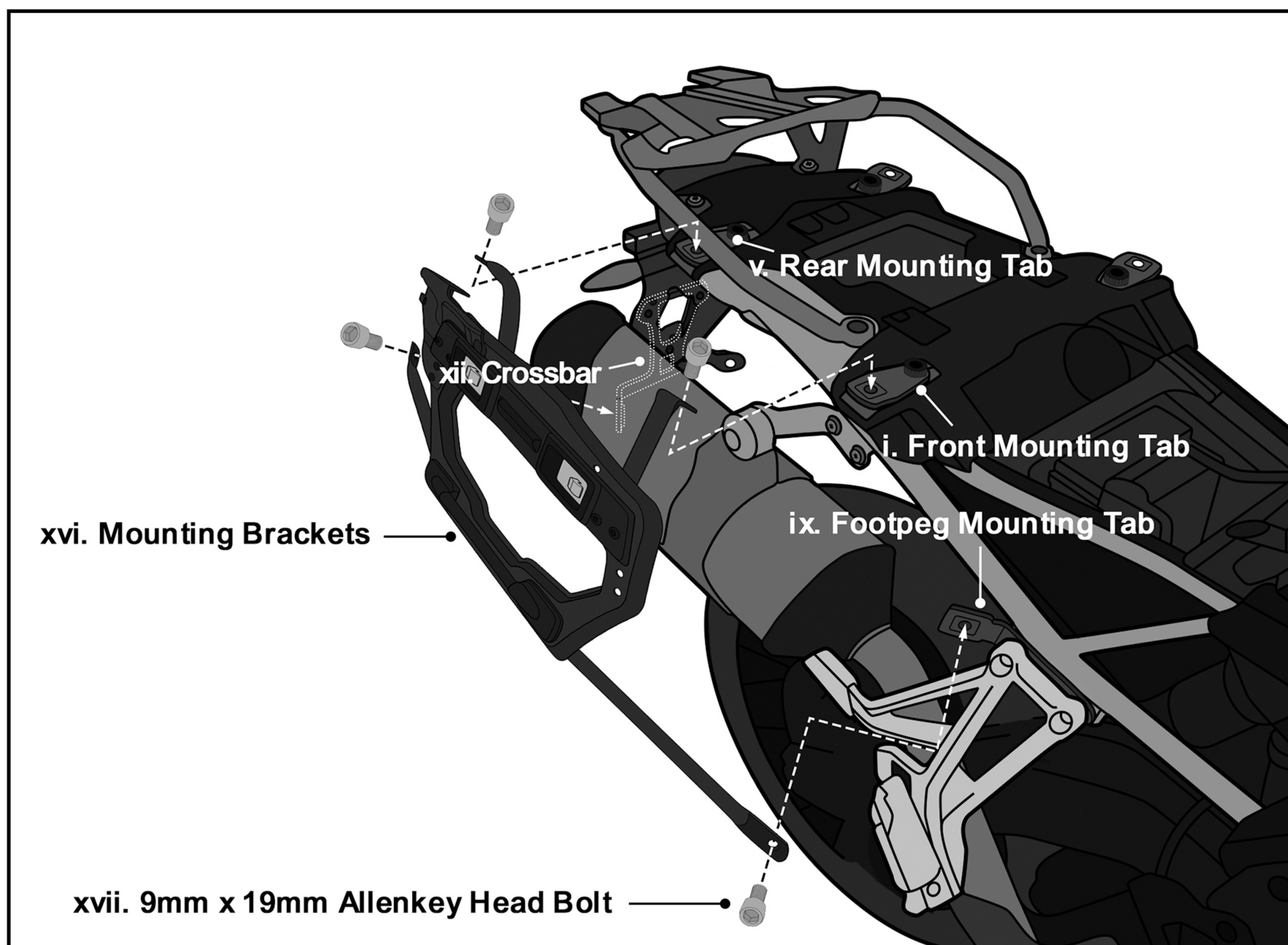


Fig 5. Attaching the bracket to the mounting tabs

Once all the hardware is in place without excess tension, tighten all the provided and OEM bolts.

Finally, attach the side cases to the mounting bracket. Pull the lever on the bracket and align the back of the side case to the hooks. Once in place push the lever down to lock the case to the bracket. Repeat the same for the other side.

Congratulations! You have successfully installed the Viking Apex Aluminium Side Cases and now you are ready to ride.
