BONAFIDE TANK BAG INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Parts

- (a) Tank Bag
- (b) Securing Straps x 4
- (c) Rain Cover

Instruction

Step 1

The bottom of the bag is equipped with strong magnets. Clean the fuel tank thoroughly before placing the bag on top of the tank to prevent any damage to the tank due to the dirt or other particles being trapped.

Step 2

Place the bag on top of the fuel tank with handle side facing the front of the bike. Ensure all magnets are securely sticking to the fuel tank.

Step 3

Loop one of the (b) securing straps to foot peg or another secure part of the bike. Once looped, hook the loose end of the strap to the rear mounting loop on the side of the tank bag. Repeat for opposite side.



Step 4

To secure the front side of the tank bag, entangle a (b) securing strap around a sturdy part of the bike (such as the front guard) and hook the loose end to the front mounting loop on the side of the tank bag. Repeat for opposite side.

Step 5

Tighten all four (b) Securing Straps such that the bag sits securely on the fuel tank under tension.

Note:

It is important that you either cut away or safely tuck in excess straps so they do not come in contact with any moving part of the bike.

- Do not use any part that is impaired or damaged. If you receive a damaged part, contact our customer service and we will be happy to help.
- If you are unsure about any installation step, do not install the bags. VikingBags is not responsible for any damage or injury caused by improper mounting or lack of maintenance.
- Regularly check for shifting of the bag and ensure all straps are in good condition and are not loose.
- No part of the bag should be in contact with any moving part of the bike during operation. This includes wheels, drive-train and exhaust.
- We recommend that you seek advice from a trained professional in case you are unsure about mounting of the bags.
