

Viking Electra Tank Bag

Installation:



Parts:

i	Mounting Bracket/Hook	x 1
ii	6mm x 20mm Bolts	x2
iii	Mounting Straps	x 2
iv	Rain Cover	x 4

Note:

- When performing Step 2 and Step 3, Do not disconnect the male/female connectors
- The tank bag is pad lockable
- When using rain cover make sure the cover is entirely tucked under the tank bag

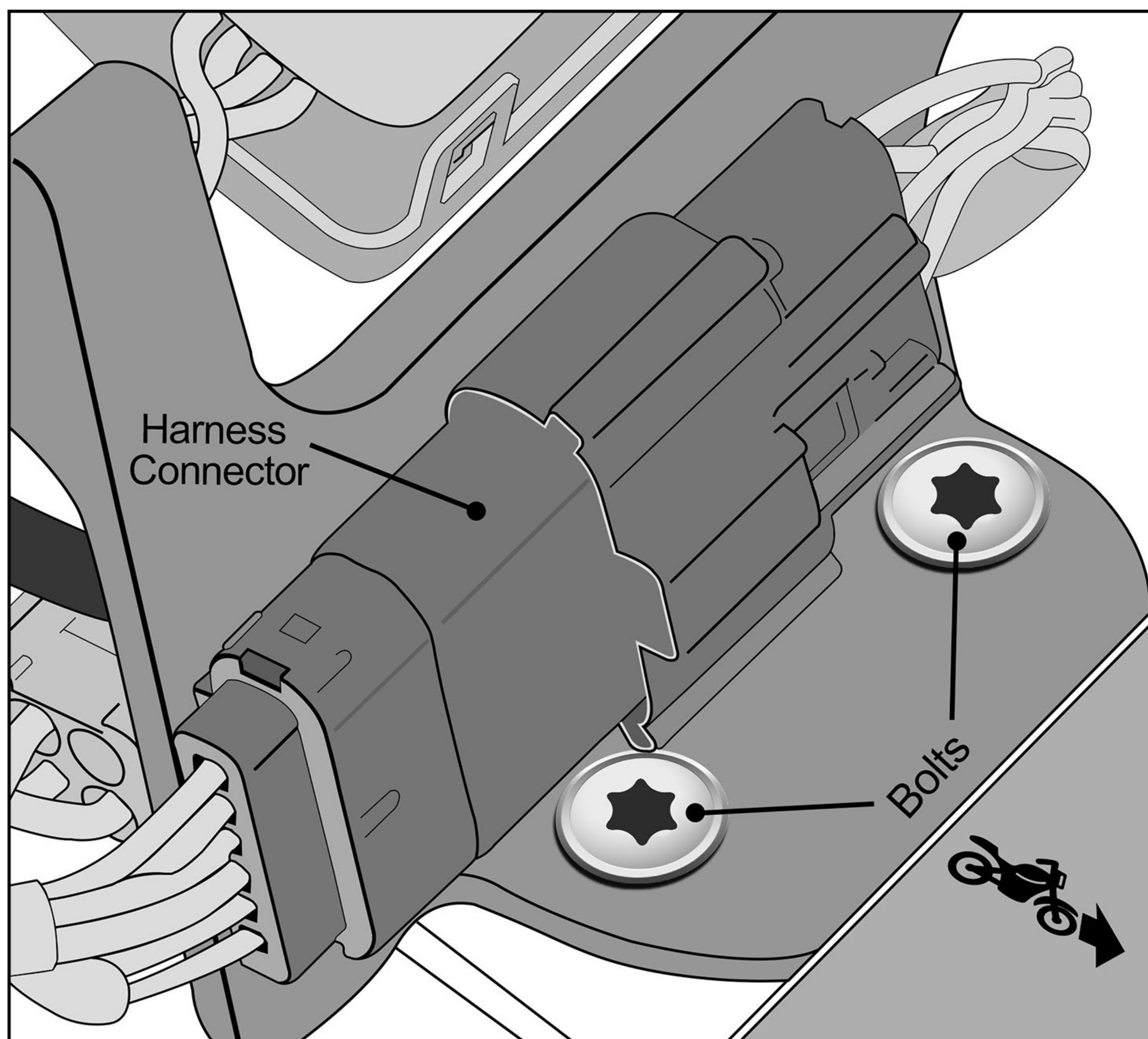
Instructions:

Step 1

Remove tank trim.

Step 2

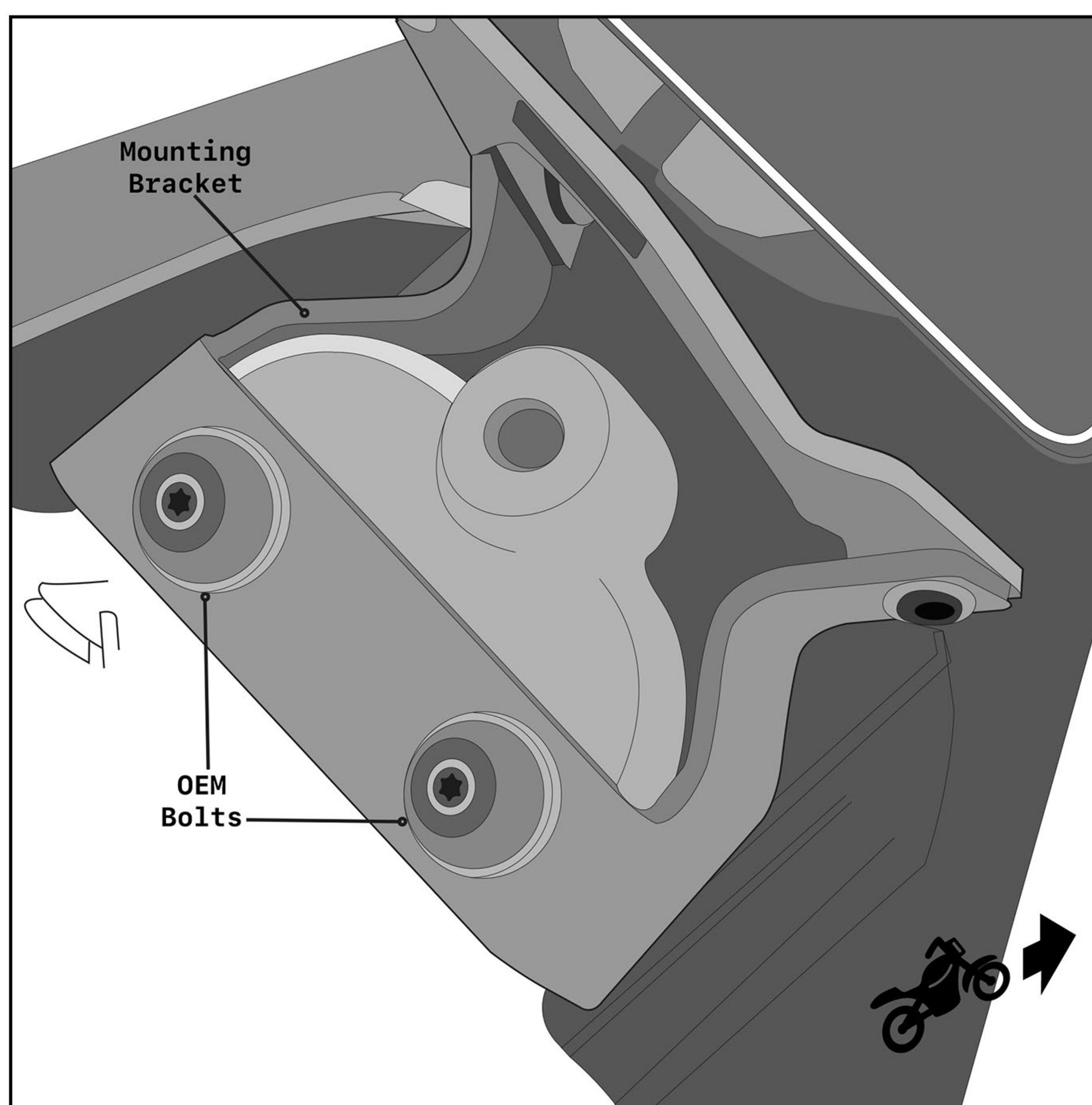
Move the harness connector away from the carrier caddy to gain access to the bolts. See Fig 1.

Step 3

Remove OEM Bolts from the carrier caddy. See Figure 2.

Step 4

Install the mounting bracket. Make sure to use the 6mm x 20mm bolts provided in the kit and discard the OEM bolts. Recommended Torque to tighten (8 - 10 N.m). See Fig 2.

Step 5

Install back the harness connector on the carrier caddy.

Step 6

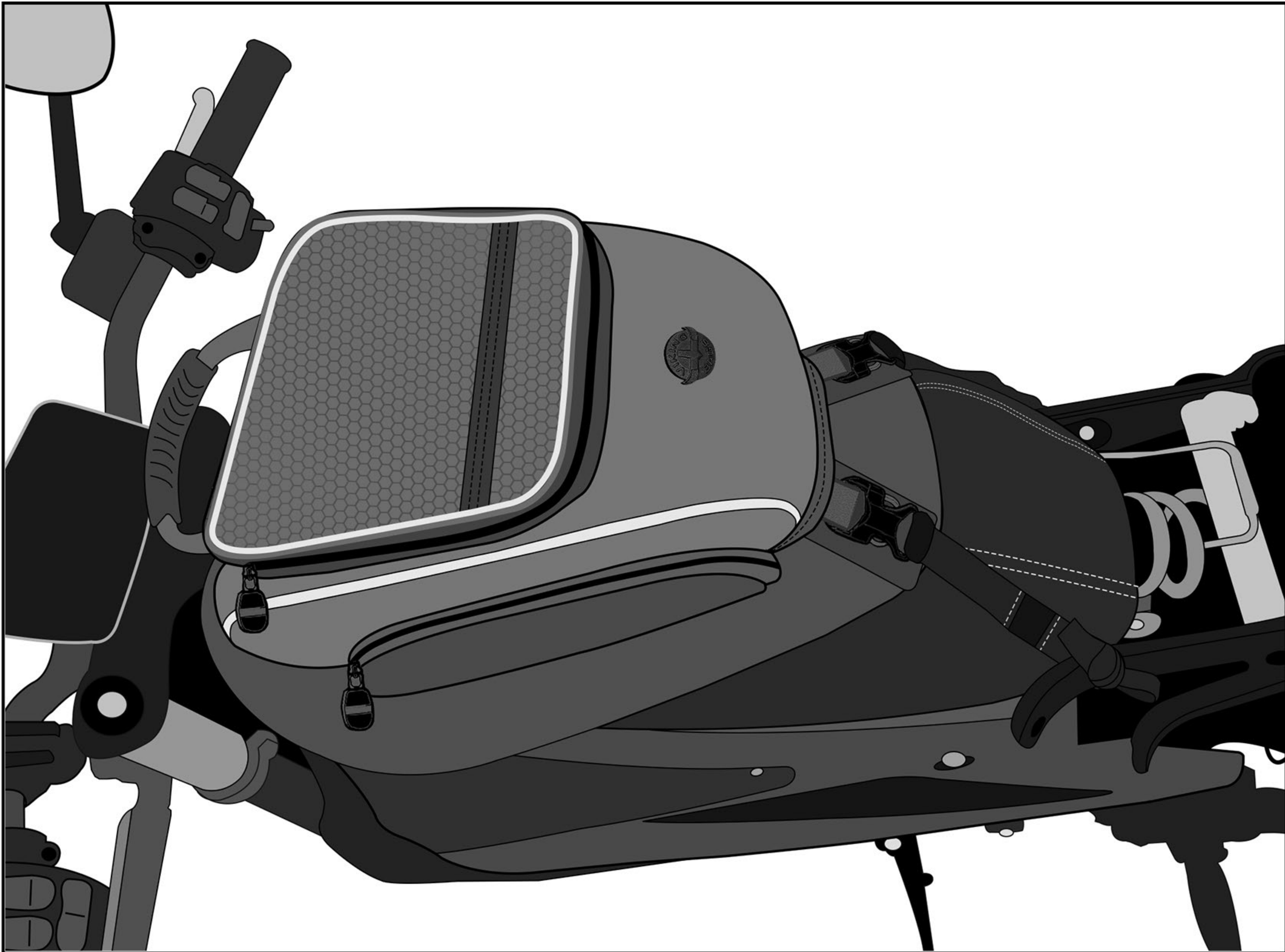
Install back tank trim.

Step 7

Install the mounting straps between the motorcycle frame and the wrapped cover. Then insert the end of the strap with the quick-release buckle into the loop at the opposite end of the strap. Repeat the step for the other side.

Step 8

Finally, mount and install the tank bag by securing it to the bracket to the front and attaching the quick-release buckles at the bottom. See Fig 3.

Step 9

Pull the mounting straps to tighten and check to see if the tank bag is securely fastened.
