VIKING MINI-SADDLEBAGS FOR SPORTS BIKES

Instructions

Step 1

Place the straps connecting the two saddlebags on top of passenger seat or the tail of the motorcycle as shown in FIG A. Adjust the straps so the bags are in a suitable position. Ensure that the bags are clear of exhaust pipes by at least 1.5 inches.

Step 2

Step 3

is holding the bag in place securely.

The saddlebags come with 4 small straps with female buckles attached. Choose 2 secure points on each side of the bike to loop the small straps around. See FIG B for reference.



Attach the male buckles on the bag to the female buckles on the loop for each of the 4 points. Tighten the straps, ensuring the tension in the straps



Step 4

Depending on the structure of your bike, you may have to attach the two bags to each other in case you do not have a secure point on either side for rear straps. In such a case, loop the two straps around each other, pass it under the tail of the bike and then attach both sides to the straps on the bag.

Combination with our Viking Sport Tail Bag.

Our Tail Bag is well suited to be mounted along with our Axe Series Saddlebags. In addition to giving your bike a coherent look, the tail bag sports 4 straps (2 at front and 2 at back) with male buckles which can be attached to the corresponding female buckles attached to our Saddlebags. See Fig. E for reference.



⚠ Warnings
