

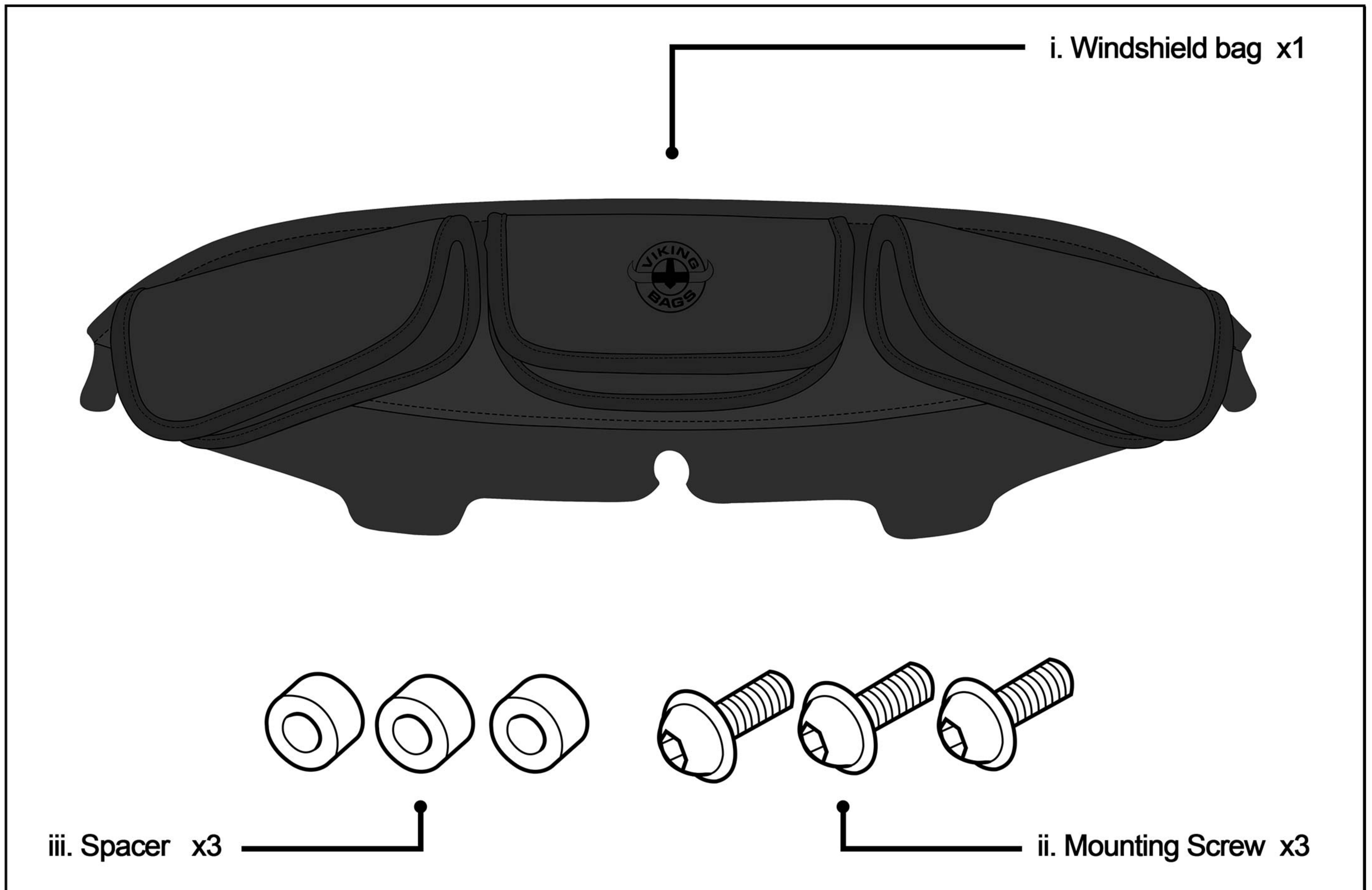
Viking Tri-Pouch Bag For Batwing Fairing:



Parts:

Step 1

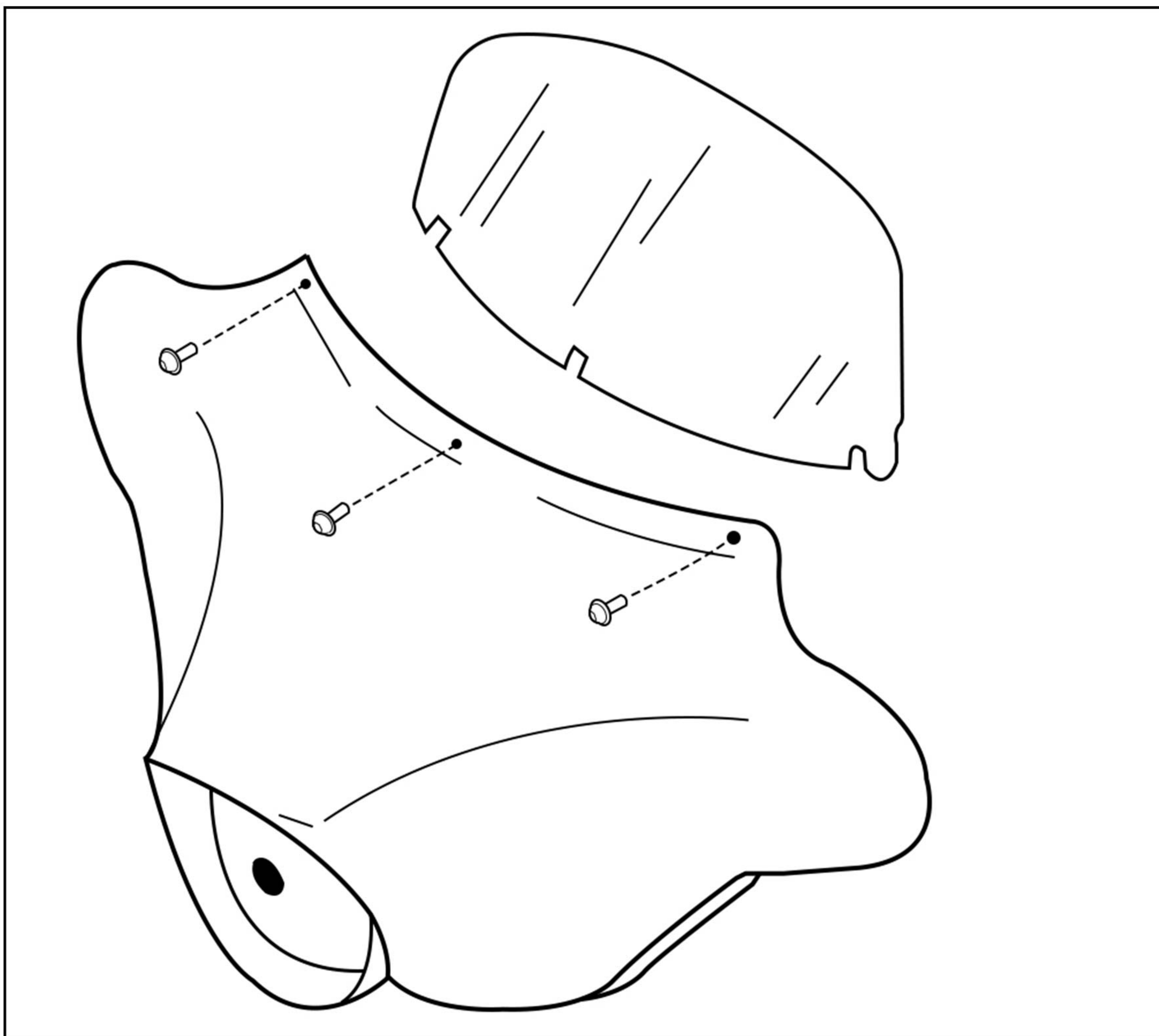


Fig 1. Removing the screws

As shown in Figure 1, remove the three front fairing screws located at the top of the fairing.

Step 2

Loosen but do not remove the last few screws holding the outer fairing to the inner fairing. Then Pull the outer fairing back gently. Remove and set aside the windshield.

Step 3

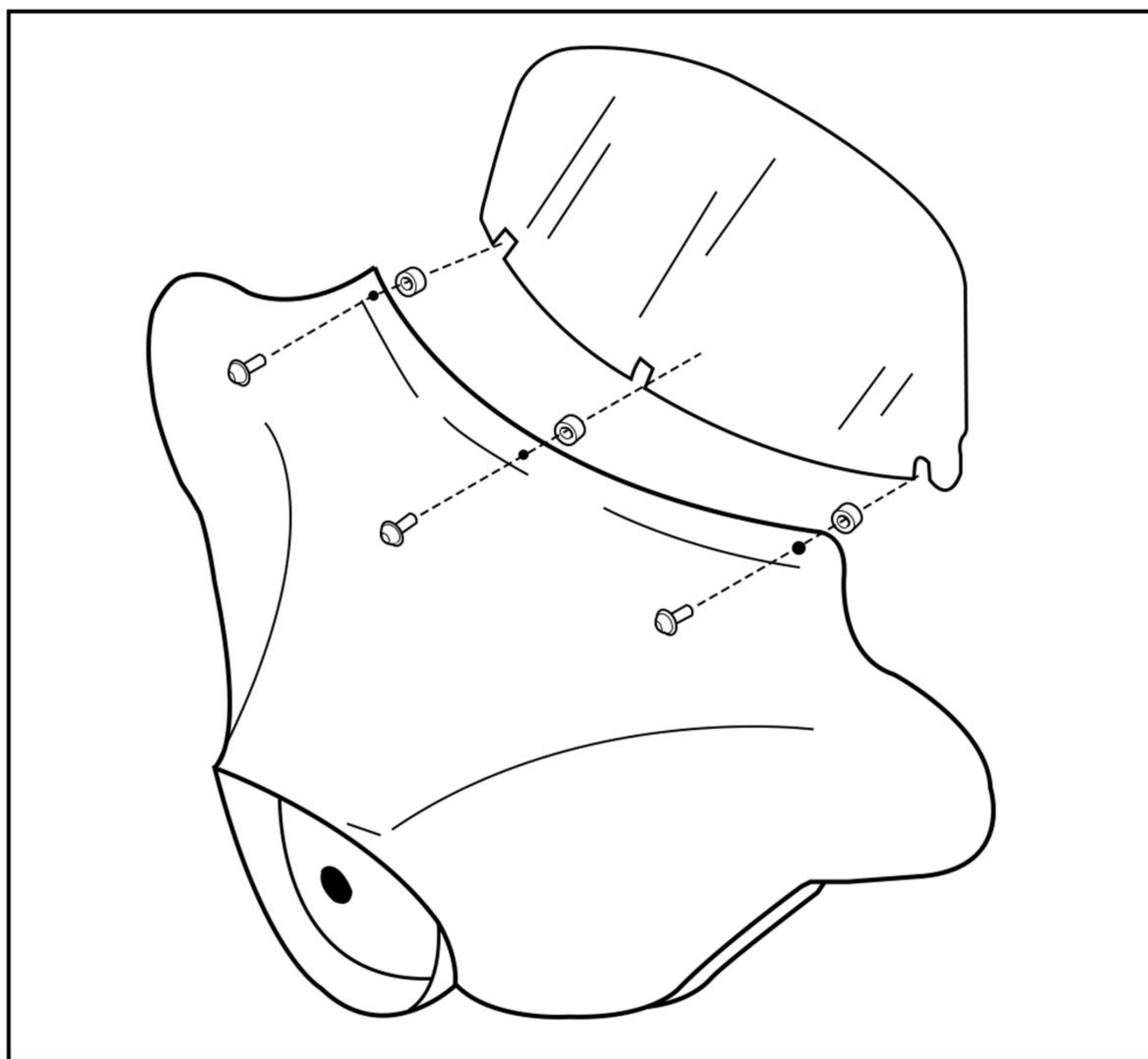


Figure 2. Install the three mounting screws and spacers.

See Figure 2. Take the three new fairing screws and spacers included in the kit. Use needle nose pliers to hold a spacer firmly between the inner and outer fairings. Screw the spacer and the outer fairing together. Tighten the screw only slightly. Repeat the procedure for the other two fairing screws and spacers.

Step 4

Place the windshield in between the inner and outer fairings.

Step 5

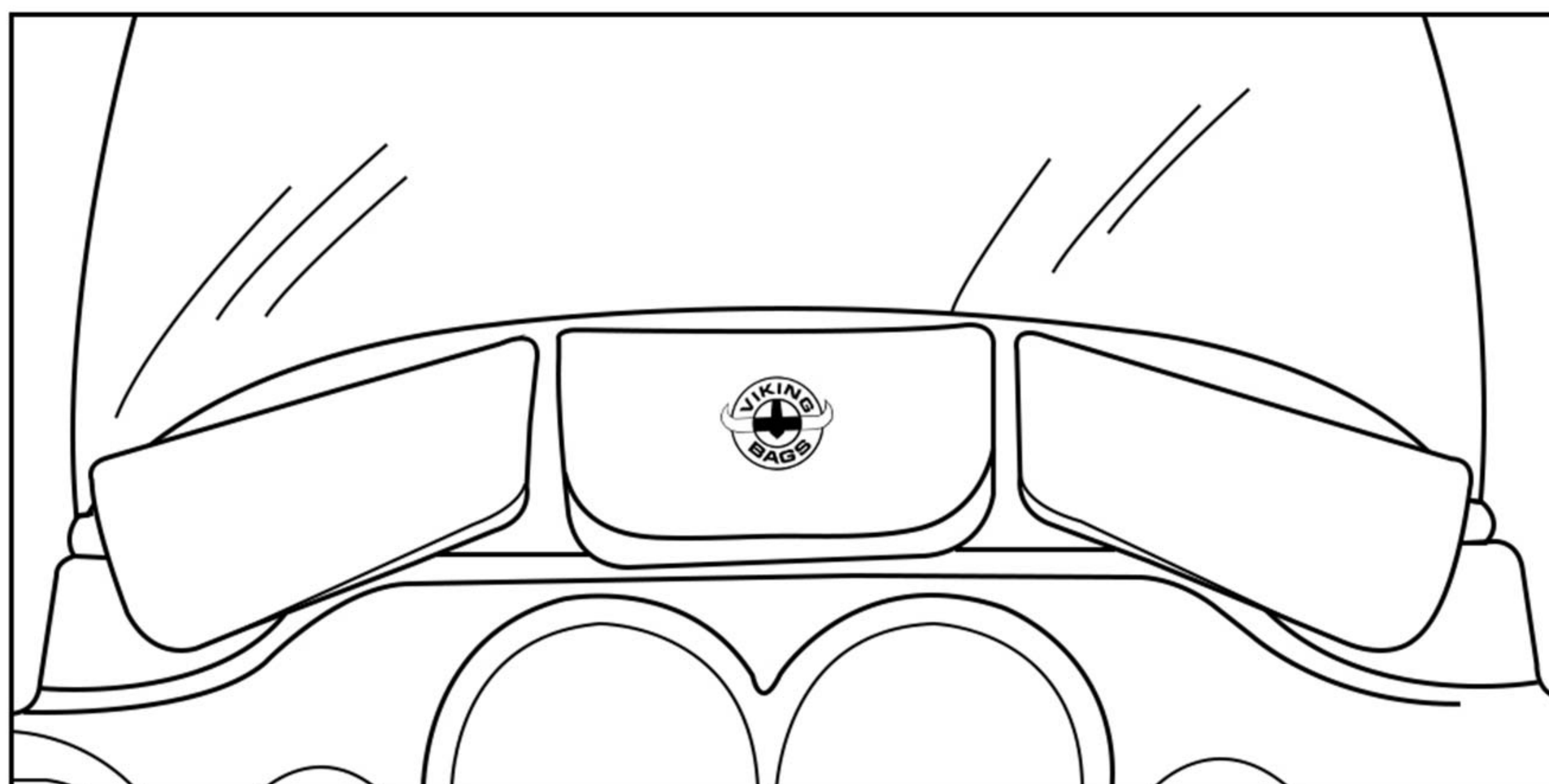


Figure 3. Sliding the bag between the windshield and the inner fairing

Install the bag between the windshield and the interior fairings. See Figure 3.

Step 6

Lastly, check that the windshield bag and the windshield are securely fastened. Tightening the three fairing screws to a torque of 2.3-3.4 Nm is recommended.
