# VIKING DAGR SISSY BAR BAG

#### **Parts Included**

Dagr Sissy Bar Bag Mounting Straps x 4 **Backpack Straps** Rain Cover


#### Instructions

#### Step 1

Place the bag on the seat or the luggage rack with flat side facing toward the backrest/sissy bar. The flat side of the bag has an adjustable sleeve which must go around the sissy bar or backrest as shown in Fig A.

## Step 2

The back side of the bag (with logo) has four D-rings. Use these D-rings to strap the bag to backrest/sissy bar uprights for increased security. The straps can be used by attaching the hook end to the D-rings and looping the open end around the uprights.



### Sleeve Adjustability

Sleeve on the Dagr Bag can be adjusted by switching the positions of metal rods into corresponding slots according to your backrest/sissy bar width.



### **Backpack Conversion**

The Dagr bag can be converted to a backpack using the supplied Backpack Straps. To convert to backpack, hook the backpack straps to the 3 backpack D-rings as Shown in Fig B.
