


Fig 1. Parts List

Instructions:

Step 1:

Place the luggage system on your motorcycle's rear and find a suitable position.

Step 2:

Once you find a suitable position, strap down the legs around your passenger foot peg or other appropriate motorcycle frames.




Fig 2. Strapping the bag to the motorcycle frame

Step 3:




Fig 3. Tying the rear straps to the motorcycle fender or luggage rack

Strap the rear straps of the bag to your bike by passing the two rear straps through your luggage rack slots or other rear tubing of the motorcycle. See Fig 3.

Step 4:

The Odyssey Luggage system is not resistant to heat. Place the heat shield included in the kit on your exhaust in a location that protects the bag. Once fully tightened, cut off any excess hose sticking out.
