

Viking Bags Quick Disconnect System Installation Guide:




Parts:		
i	10 mm Docking post (2 installed and 2 in the hardware box)	x4
ii	Fender washer	x8
iii	Split Lock Washer	x8
iv	Nuts	x4
٧	Bolts	x4


Tools Needed:

- i Screw Driver
- ii Combination Wrench
- iii Power Drill with 8mm bit
- iv Marker


Parts Diagram:

Quick Disconnect Hardware

Step 1:

Remove fender bolts

Step 2:

Mount docking posters in each of the two fender holes

Step 3:

Make sure to put the key lock in unlock position and loosen the bolts on the bracket so the sliders are free. Then you can adjust the slider such that you can easily insert the docking post into the slots in the sliders

Step 4:

Once installed, tighten the bolts and make sure the fitment is smooth





Fig 1. Tightening the bolts on the bottom

Step 5:

Hold the bag onto the bike's bracket, ensuring clearance from moving parts and exhaust. Mark the bracket outline on the bag with chalk or marker.







Step 6:

Place the bag on a clean soft surface with back facing up. Unmount the bracket and place it on the back of the bag such the bracket aligns with the marked outline. Then mark the five holes onto the bag. 2 holes are located in the sliding and the other 3 are on the bottom of the bracket.

Step 7:

Remove the bracket and drill the 5 marked points

Step 8:

Once drilled, start from inside the bag, pass the mounting bolts on the sliders through the back of the bag and then through the bracket, and tighten the bolts using provided nuts.




Fig 3. Installing the bracket to the bag

Step 9:

Mount the bracket onto the docking posts installed on the fender. Once properly in place, lock the bracket and take away the key. Make sure that all the bolts are tight. We recommended that you use blue lock tight with all the bolts






Fig 4. Bag mounted on the bike with the Quick Disconnect System
