

Directions to 2015 Mendocino Planting



These trees are easily accessible, although we don't recommend you visit between Oct-May, as there may be muddy roads and/or snow on the ground

From Williams, CA (it will take about 2 hours):

- Take 5N to Maxwell Colusa Rd. Take exit 586 from I-5 N and turn left
- Follow Maxwell Sites Rd and Sites Lodoga Rd to Ladoga-Stonyford Rd (Follow signs to Stonyford- it'll take about an hour)
- Once in town, turn left on Market/East Park Road.
- Soon you'll turn left on Fout Springs Road (M10)
- In about 6 miles, you'll turn left on Trough Spring Ridge (M5) (M5 is dirt, but a well maintained road. We'd recommend going in an SUV June-Sept, and a 4 wheel drive vehicle Oct-May.)
- Set your mileage meter to ZERO right when you turn ton M5*
- Stop anywhere along M5 between 8.0 and 9.0 miles and park
- Our trees are planted on the right side of the road
- If you reach Forest Road 17N96 on the right, you've gone too far
