The licence plate gets locked-and-unlocked by sliding the Plate part which is mounted on the license plate, from top to bottom, onto the Bike part.


Make sure that the two components completely flush with each other.

- Caliper




Plate part hole psacing: 55mm










OPTIONAL: License plate with additional fasteners





When using additional retaining etcdevices (licence plate holder, aluminium or carbon plates*, etc.), particular care must be taken that the maximum permissible load of the plate part of 0.2 kg is not exceeded.

BENEFIT: If additional retaining elements are used, no central holes are required in the licence plate. Also the licence plate is additionally protected and strengthened.
