Max Performance Collar with USB Charger

Remove any collars and tags before fitting the **Furwear No Bark Max Performance Collar** to your dog. Make sure you can pass two fingers between the collar and their neck at all points. Adjust as nessesary. Once the collar is attached, wait for at least 10 minutes before activating to prevent your dog from getting "Collar Smart".


Press the ON button. Then press either the sound or vibration button, depending on the method that you would like to use to train your dog.


Your **Furwear No Bark Max Performance Collar** has low to high levels of sensitivity. This can be adjusted by pressing the sensitivity (S) button. To adjust, press the S button a few times from levels 1-7, with 1 being the lowest sensitivity and 7 the highest, to reach the

We recommend starting your training on the lowest level and increasing only if your dog does not respond.

When not in use, press the OFF button to save battery life.

How to charge your Furwear No Bark Max Performance Collar:

Charging your unit is a simple process. All that is required is to pull the USB seal tab open and attach the USB cord to the collar. Then, attach the other end to a computer or charging port. Once collar is fully charged, remove the USB cord and close the rubber seal tightly to ensure that the collar remains waterproof.

Only use your **Furwear No Bark Max Performance Collar** for a maximum of 8-9 hours per day before turning off. Make sure to leave the collar on for a further 10 minutes before removing to avoid your dog from getting 'Collar Smart.'

Training your dog does not have to be a stressful or overwhelming job. We recommend working with your pet to find the best training method for you both. To successfully train your pet, we recommend using the collar in combination with other training methods, and to monitor and encourage good behavior through praise and treats when your dog has positively reacted to the collar and ceased barking. By praising and rewarding positive behavior, you will see results much sooner and speed up the training process.
