

Makes: 24 Prep Time: 5-10min Cook Time: 30min

Ingredients

Pupcakes

- 4 cups wholemeal flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 2 cups water
- 1 cup unsweetened apple sauce
- 2 carrots (grated)
- 1 egg
- 2 tbsp honey
- 2 bananas (mashed)

Icing

- 250g cream cheese
- 2 tbsp peanut butter
- 2 tbsp honey

Method

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°C
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together flour, baking powder, and cinnamon.
- 3. In a seperate bowl, mix together water, apple sauce, carrots, egg, honey, and mashed bananas. Once incorporated, add in the flour mixture until well combined.
- 4. Line a muffin tray with cupcake cases and lightly grease inside the cupcake cases for easy removal. Spoon the mixture into the cupcake cases until about 3/4 full.
- 5. Bake for 30 minutes, or until the mixture is cooked. To test if your pupcakes are cooked, simply insert a toothpick into the centre of a pupcake and if it comes out clean then it's cooked.
- 6. Allow pupcakes to cool completly before icing.
- 7. To make the icing, beat the cream cheese, peanut butter, and honey until it is a smooth consistency. Ice the pupcakes and decorate (optional)

Top Tip!

Decorate your pupcakes with crushed dog biscuits, shredded coconut, crushed liver treats, carob or yoghurt dog friendly buttons/drops, or shredded carrots. Be sure to remove the cupcake cases before giving them to your dog.

Pupcakes will last up to a week and can be frozen.
