Project: Supporting the Preparation for Exhibition at the Africa Climate Summit (ACS)

Africa Climate Summit (ACS) 2023 was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at the Kenyatta International Convention Center (KICC) in Nairobi. The conference took place in parallel with the 2023 Africa Climate week and was attended by at least twenty African Heads of states and close to twenty thousand (20,000) delegates from all over the Africa Continent. The 2023 Africa Climate Summit, the first of its kind, was intended to fill the gaps arising from the COP 27 Implementation Plan, including building trust within the global community and delivering concrete outcomes. The conference brought together global leaders, Regional Economic Communities, United Nations agencies, private sector, intergovernmental organizations, civil society organizations, indigenous peoples, local communities, farmer organizations, children, youth, women and academia to discuss Africa's climate change challenges and formulate sustainable solutions. Hosted by the Kenyan president, his Excellency Dr. William Ruto, the leaders expressed concern that Africa faces disproportionate burdens and risks from climate change-related events yet it is not historically responsible for global warming. They acknowledged that climate change is the greatest challenge facing humanity and the biggest threat to all life on earth and Africa bears the brunt of its effect, impacting lives, livelihoods and economies. The leaders also emphasized that despite all these challenges, the continent possessed the potential and the ambition to be a vital component of the global solution to climate change.

Back to Basics hosted a booth at the Africa Climate Summit Expo Center, to showcase its work and initiatives on climate action interventions. The Exhibition provided an opportunity for participants of the Africa Climate Summit and Africa Climate Week to interact, network and learn about our organization and the work we do. We showcased how we train communities on turning their waste into livelihoods. Some of the products on display included Scarfs, hand warmers, Bamboo bags and Climate action Bags from recycled material. We were able to interact with thousands of delegates who visited our booth and displayed so much interest in our work.
