Instructions / Windows 10 / English

- 1. If you need help at any time then please email bob@iso2disk.com
- 2. Back up all data and photos that are important to you.
- 3. Ensure the disk or USB is ready in the computer when powered down.
- 4. You now need to bring up the boot menu.
- 5. Power up your computer and keep pressing the "boot key" at the same time.
- 6. The "boot key" is F12 for Dell, F9 for HP and sometimes F2 for other makes.
- 7. You should get the "boot menu" on the screen.
- 8. Select the Disk or USB and press "return" to start the installation.
- 9. You may see a message "press any key to boot from DVD", if so, immediately press a key.
- 10. Select "64 bit" or "32 bit" if you see this option. If not, just wait.
- 11. You need to wait a while for the next screen to appear.
- 12. Select country settings and click "next".
- 13. Click "install now" for a fresh installation.
- 14. There is a "repair" option at this stage which can be used to attempt a repair.
- 15. Click "I don't have a product key". This can be added once the install has finished.
- 16. Choose the version you wish to load (Home or Pro).
- 17. Accept the license terms.
- 18. Click on "Custom (Advanced)".
- 19. You can attempt an "upgrade" at this stage. This will save all your files and applications.
- 20. Click "Drive Options" (advanced).
- 21. Click on partitions in turn and delete all.
- 22. When this is done you will end up with just one line (disk 0 unallocated space).
- 23. You will see a yellow "new" icon (do not click on this).
- 24. Click "next" Do not click on "new".
- 25. Windows 10 will now start to load (this can take around 30 minutes).
- 26. Choose your region.
- 27. Click on Keyboard region.
- 28. Skip second keyboard option.
- 29. Click on "I don't have internet" (this can be added later).
- 30. Click "continue with limited set up".
- 31. Input a user name. You can leave password blank.
- 32. Say "no" and "deny" all options (these can be changed later).
- 33. Click on "Not Now" for Cortana.
- 34. Continue until complete.
- 35. Once complete you can add your Wifi details.
- 36. When done take out your disk or USB.
- 37. It is best now to delete all start up programs so you have a clean screen with no pop ups.
- 38. Press at the same time the keys "Ctrl", "Alt" and "Del"/"Delete" and a menu will appear.
- 39. Click on "Task Manager".
- 40. In the bottom left corner, click on "More Details".
- 41. Click on "Start Up" in menu bar at the top.
- 42. Click on those that are "Enabled" and disable them by clicking on "Disable" in the bottom right.
- 43. Restart and you are all done.
- 44. You can now perform "updates" which will perform all updates and add any drivers which may be missing.

Activation, Microsoft Office and Windows 11 options

- 1 You will need to activated Windows 10. If you have a key you can enter it to activate.
