
# **INSTALLATION GUIDE**



#### **52137 Bucket Seat Set** FORD TRANSIT CONNECT (2018-2019) Fold Flat Passenger Seat



# **BILL OF MATERIALS**

Driver Seat Back Cover	1
Driver Seat Bottom Cover	1
Passenger Seat Back Cover	1
Passenger Seat Bottom Cover	1
Driver Headrest Cover	1
Passenger Headrest Cover	1

Seat Backs & Bottoms have tag signifying Driver or Passenger.

Ensure airbag patch (same side as the TigerTough tag) goes on the outside edge of the seat.

#### General care instructions:

- 1. In most cases dirt, debris, spills and pet hair can be removed by wiping with a damp cloth.
- 2. Seat covers can be removed and machine washed on low temperature setting using mild detergent.

Drip dry or machine tumble dry on a no heat cycle.

Straps should be coiled and secured with rubber bands for machine washing and drying.

- 3. Soil may be removed with spray cleaner or detergent and water.
- 4. Oil or grease stains should first be treated with a dry cleaning solvent followed by a spray cleaner or detergent and water.
- 5. Do not use bleach.



# **1 - Preparation**



- □ 1.1 Slide seat forward and raise to highest position, if possible.
- 1.2 Remove headrest by pressing in tabs at base of headrest and pulling up. Press the small tab on the inside of the headrest mount with a paperclip or small clip.



## 2 - Install Driver's Seat Bottom Cover





- **2**.1 Ensure the tag inside the cover corresponds with the seat you are working on.
- □ 2.2 Lean seat back.
- **2**.3 Undo elastic straps from under seat bottom to release seat back flap.
- **2**.4 Push flap on top of cover between seat back and seat bottom.
- □ 2.5 Tuck sides of cover behind plastic trim.
- 2.6 Push strings between seat bottom and plastic trim. They will go through where the seat back and bottom meet.
- □ 2.7 Pull strings behind seat and pull tight.
- □ 2.8 Tie a loop in one string, close to the edge of the seat.
- □ 2.9 Run the other string through the loop and pull as tight as possible. This is what keeps your seat bottom from shifting.
- 2.10 Pull bottom flaps from front of seat bottom and attach to top flap under the rear of the seat.
- 2.11 Flaps MUST run OVER bars and brackets under seat.



#### **3 - Install Driver's Seat Back Cover**



- $\Box$  3.1 Turn cover 3/4 of the way inside out.
- **I** 3.2 Pull cover over seat back, pulling tight against the top of the seat.
- **3**.3 Align the holes in the cover with the headrest holes on the seat back.
- **3**.4 Work the plastic trim around the headrest holes through the holes in the seat cover.
- □ 3.5 Pull the cover down over the seat, unrolling as you go.
- □ 3.6 Push the front flap of the cover between the seat back and seat bottom.
- **3**.7 Pull flap tight and fasten to Velcro under seat bottom.
- □ 3.8 Re-attach elastic straps under seat bottom.
- **3**.9 Pull the rear flap tight and fasten to Velcro under seat bottom.



### 4 - Install Passenger's Seat Bottom Cover





- □ 4.1 Ensure the tag inside the cover corresponds with the seat you are working on.
- □ 4.2 Lean seat back.
- □ 4.3 Undo elastic straps from under seat bottom to release seat back flap.
- □ 4.4 Push flap on top of cover between seat back and seat bottom.
- □ 4.5 Tuck sides of cover behind plastic trim.
- 4.6 Push strings between seat bottom and plastic trim. They will go through where the seat back and bottom meet.
- □ 4.7 Pull strings behind seat and pull tight.
- □ 4.8 Tie a loop in one string, close to the edge of the seat.
- □ 4.9 Run the other string through the loop and pull as tight as possible. This is what keeps your seat bottom from shifting.
- □ 4.10 Pull bottom flaps from front of seat bottom and attach to top flap under the rear of the seat.
- □ 4.11 Flaps MUST run OVER bars and brackets under seat.



#### **5 - Install Passenger's Seat Back Cover**



- □ 5.1 Ensure the tag inside the cover corresponds with the seat you are working on.
- **5**.2 Undo elastic strap holding seat back flap from under seat bottom (Black strap with white clip).
- **I** 5.3 Tip seat back flap up and tuck inside seat cover as you pull it down.
- □ 5.4 Turn seat cover 3/4 of the way inside out.
- **5**.5 Pull seat back cover into position, making sure that the holes in the cover align with the holes in the seat back.
- □ 5.6 Stretch the cover over the headrest holes.
- 5.7 Continue pulling the cover down the seat back, turning it right side out as you go.
- $\Box$  5.8 Push flap from front of cover between seat back and seat bottom, out the back of the seat .
- □ 5.9 Lean the seat back all the way forward.
- □ 5.10 Pull the flap tight and attach to the Velcro on the back of the seat.



# 7 - Install Headrest Cover



- □ 7.1 Put headrest back in seat by pressing plastic tabs and pushing down on headrest.
- □ 7.2 Pull cover over headrest with "loop" Velcro in front and "hook" Velcro in rear.
- □ 7.3 Fasten Velcro tabs together under headrest.
