*Basically, you break it, we buy it.
Seriously.*

Your new seat covers are covered by a two-year, unconditional, no B.S. warranty.

That means that if you manage to abuse them to a point that they can't perform like they're supposed to within two years of when you bought them, we'll make it right. Depending on what is more practical, we'll either repair or replace the damaged cover.

General care instructions:

1. In most cases dirt, debris, spills and pet hair can be removed by wiping with a damp cloth.
2. Seat covers can be removed and machine washed on low temperature setting using mild detergent.
Drip dry or machine tumble dry on a no heat cycle.
Straps should be coiled and secured with rubber bands for machine washing and drying.
3. Soil may be removed with spray cleaner or detergent and water.
4. Oil or grease stains should first be treated with a dry cleaning solvent followed by a spray cleaner or detergent and water.
5. Do not use bleach.

Install Seat Back & Headrest

Undo velcro on the seat back. Slide cover over the seat back and headrest with the pocket on the back of the seat.

Fasten velcro flaps below the headrest to the velcro inside the seat cover.

Work cover down the seatback.

Put headrest cover on with the flap towards the front.

Secure flap to the velcro sewn on the inside of the headrest cover.

Push the flap at the bottom in between the seat back and bottom.

Secure flap to the velcro sewn on the inside of the headrest cover.

Pull flap tight and secure velcro.



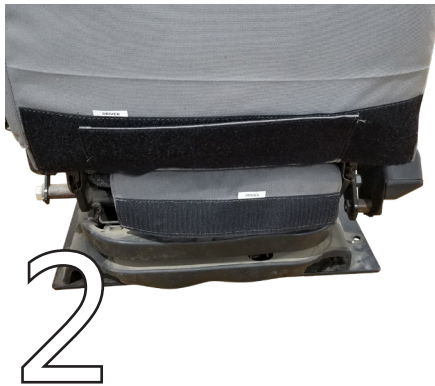

Install Seat Bottom Cover

Slide seat bottom cover on with the velcro flap towards the back.



Push velcro flap between the seat back and seat bottom.



[View from back of seat]

Pull tight and secure to velcro.
