## Bracelet / Cuff Size Guide

Measuring your wrist is the best way to determine your correct bracelet and cuff size.

Before using the ruler to find your fit, make sure this guide is printed on A4 size paper and scaled to $100 \%$. To check the accuracy of your printout, position a credit card under the line below. The scale is correct if the credit card and line length match.

## Method 1: Measure your wrist with our Alokki ruler

- Cut out the ruler.
- Cut a horizontal line below the alokki logo.
- Wrap the ruler around the circumference of your wrist with the numbered side visible.
- Slip the numbered end through the horizontal opening and pull until the ruler is flush against your skin.
- The number that lines up with the edge of the opening is your wrist size in inches.

Method 2: Measure your wrist with the measuring tape or piece of paper or string
