Ring Size Guide

Method 1: Determine the Circumference (If you don't have Ring)



1. Cut a strip of paper or string long enough to fit around your finger



2. Wrap the paper or string around, not too tight, aim for comfortable, snug fit



3. Mark where two meets



4. Measure the length of the paper or string from tip to pencil mark in mm

If you have measurement falls between two sizes, It is recommended that you choose the larger size



Method 2: Determine the Inner Diameter (If I have a Ring)

1. Place the ring on the ruler

2. Measure the distance between the far ends of the inner circle, which is actually the diameter.



3. Find out your ring size using the below chart
