San Leonardo have been producing wine since 1215 when a monastery was first built on the estate. They now produce one of the greatest Bordeaux Blend wines in Italy gaining international acclaim, but in tragically small volumes. We explore how the wine has changed over the years tasting the wine through 6 vintages, finishing with their incredible Estate made Grappa.

## **Bordeaux Demystified**

What is the difference between Left-Bank and Right-Bank, and why should you care? We take a tour around Bordeaux and its star regions and what makes them so unique.

#### **Best of British**

Air is a conduit for aroma and flavour. The palate-deadening effect of cabin pressure and diminished air quality flattens flavours and masks more subtle, secondary characteristics in wines. Generally; bold, spicy, more concentrated, fruit-centred wines withstand the diminishing effects better. Using the results of recent tastings with our private aviation partners, we will enjoy those styles of wine which perform best at altitude.
