Framingham State College - Grade Reporting

At Framingham State College we report coursework on a per course basis. Each graduate course that is part of a degree program is four credits and is shown on the student transcript as "1.0". Courses that are less than four credits are shown as a portion of "1.0". A three credit course is ".75", a two credit course is ".5" and a one credit course is ".25". There is a short definition of this method on the reverse side of an official transcript.

Course Credit:

- 1.00 Course-Credit is equivalent to 4.0 credits (or semester hours)
- 0.75 Course-Credit is equivalent to 3.0 credits (or semester hours)
- 0.50 Course-Credit is equivalent to 2.0 credits (or semester hours)
- 0.25 Course-Credit is equivalent to 1.0 credit (or semester hour)
