## Option 2 - Measure your finger with string or strip of paper

1. Cut a length of string, floss, or paper and wrap it around the base of the intended finger.
2. Use a pen to mark where the floss or string first overlaps.
3. Stretch the length of string out along the ruler to the right to find your ring measurement.

Tip: String and floss can stretch, so try not to pull too taut around your finger.
