How to Make Ocean Resin Art

The secret to creating beautiful, realistic ocean resin art is tinted epoxy resin and a hairdryer. Resin is essential to creating realistic ocean art: it's clarity, consistency and gloss replicate the look of water in a way you can't get with any other medium.



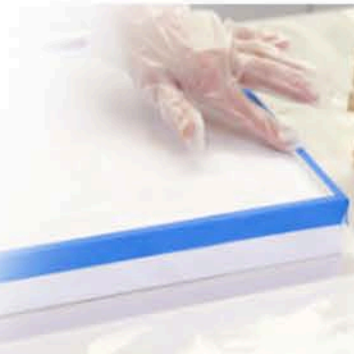
What You'll Need:

- ArtResin epoxy resin
- ResinTint Original colorants
- Painter's tape
- a wooden panel, round or square
- a hairdryer
- ArtResin Accessory Kit
- Level
- plastic mixing cup
- 4 small plastic cups and stir sticks
- a piece of plastic/vinyl to work on
- an Artist's Torch
- dust cover large enough to cover your piece

How to Make Ocean Resin Art

1 To keep the panel edges clean, tape them off with painter's tape



2 Prepare Your ArtResin and ResinTints



- 1** dark turquoise (blue & green)
- 2** light turquoise (blue, green and white)
- 3** white
- 4** sand (neon green, pink, yellow & white)



3 Start with the sand color to create the beach



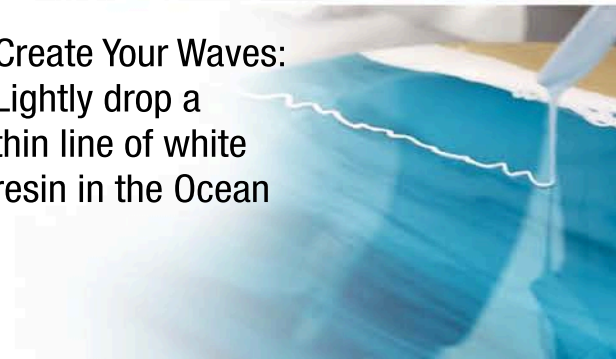
4 Apply the dark turquoise to about half of your panel



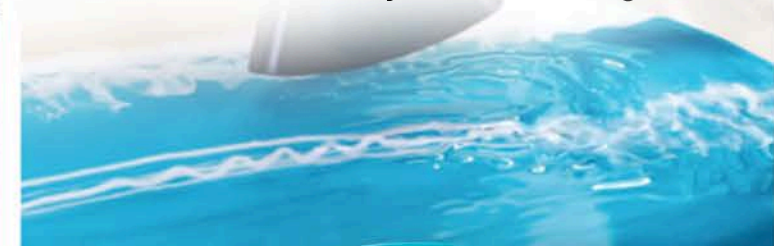
5 Apply the lighter turquoise to the remainder of the panel. Blend in dark and light.



6 Create Your Waves: Lightly drop a thin line of white resin in the Ocean



7 Make Your Waves Crash: Push the white lines with the hairdryer's low setting



8 Torch the resin to remove bubbles



9 Cover and wait overnight



And voilà... your own beautiful, one of a kind, aerial beach scene!
