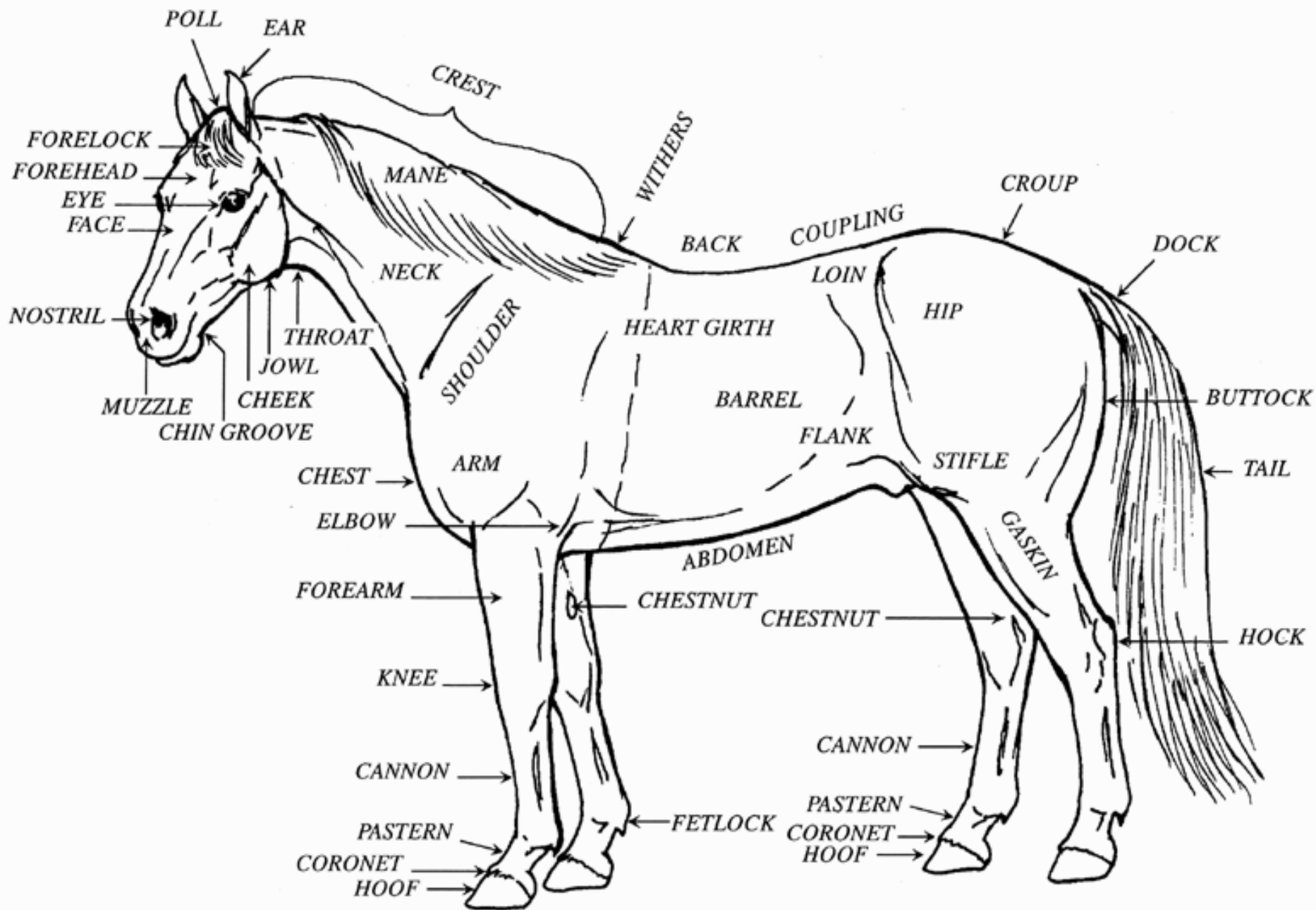


PARTS OF THE HORSE





Rudy says: Let's have some fun learning about parts of a horse!

- 1) Many parts of the horse are similar to human body parts. Which ones can you find? (critical thinking)
Examples: knee, hip, elbow, chest, chin, ears, cheek

- 2) What are some horse body parts that are very different from human body parts? (critical thinking)
Examples: tail, muzzle, withers, hoof, fetlock

- 3) Can you create some riddles about the parts of the horse? (critical thinking, double meaning words)

Examples:

What part of the horse sounds like something you would use to brush your teeth? (crest)

What happens to a flower when it dies? (it withers)

What might you roast on an open fire? (chestnut)

What part of the horse might be used in a battle? (cannon)

- 4) Can you think of ways to group some parts of the horse together? (categorization/critical thinking)

Examples:

Parts of the leg

Parts that begin with the /k/ sound

Parts that are double meaning words (poll, cannon, chestnut, tail, chest, muzzle)
