




A world akin to a treasure trove

Security:


All the casks are insured against various damaging events and against theft. The insured sum is adjusted annually.

Quality:

The Alpinist together with Ron Volcán and external experts takes care of purchasing the rum and ensuring it undergoes regular quality checks.

Monitoring:

Ron Volcán supervises storage, complying with strict, legal provisions governing alcohol warehouses and is supervised during this task by external fiduciaries.




Timeless and unpolished beauty

Castles, lakes and landscapes chiselled by the weather - like an uncut diamond. Scotland rewards those who take the time to discover it, time and again. Anybody visiting the rugged landscape of the Scottish Highlands will immediately notice that here nature and history go hand in hand. Although it is unclear who initially brought whisky to Scotland, documents show that "uisge" - the Gaelic word for water, which over the years evolved into today's word "whisky" - was distilled in monasteries as early as the 15th century.

Monarchs soon discovered the Water of Life, and the pleasure of consuming it was followed by taxes and prohibitions. Monks retired to the Highlands and to the islands and continued distilling at night when the mist concealed the plumes of smoke. A legend was born and as years went by, the secret evolved into a respectable craft. A history spanning more than 500 years and a unique terroir - both are part and parcel of Scottish whisky.

The path to premium malt

Barley. Barley is the only cereal in single malt whisky originating from Scotland. But the earth where it is grown and the peatiness used to dry the barley are what make whisky unique. It is distilled using the pot-still method: each distillery has its individually crafted copper still, further refining the whisky's flavour. Whisky culminates its maturation process in a carefully selected cask. It often has a prehistory which determines its final character. Many whiskies only attain their zenith in terms of flavour between 10 and 15 years later on. As connoisseurs are well aware, whisky only has one master: Father Time.

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Maturation imparts character - the same can be said of whisky. The longer it remains in the cask, the mellower its flavour, the richer its aromatic panoply. As soon as it is bottled, the maturation process comes to an end.
