- Do not install the device in rooms with high humidity (for example, in bathrooms, laundry rooms, damp basements).

Installing the adapter on the phone

1. Remove the adapter's protective cap.
2. Insert the adapter into the USB port of the phone.
3. Press the settings key  on the phone.
4. In the **Settings** menu, select **Network** and press the OK key .
5. In the **Network** menu, select **WLAN** and press the OK key .
6. In the **WLAN** menu (Fig. 1), press to switch the WLAN toggle to **on**. More items are added to the menu (Fig. 2).
7. Select **Scan WLAN** and press to initiate scanning.
8. Select one of the detected wireless LANs and press .
9. Enter the password for the selected WLAN and press .
10. Reboot the phone.
 - Press the function key underneath the reboot symbol  on the display (Fig. 3).
 - Alternatively, press  and select **Maintenance** > **Reboot** and press .

A reboot is also necessary after switching WLAN off.
