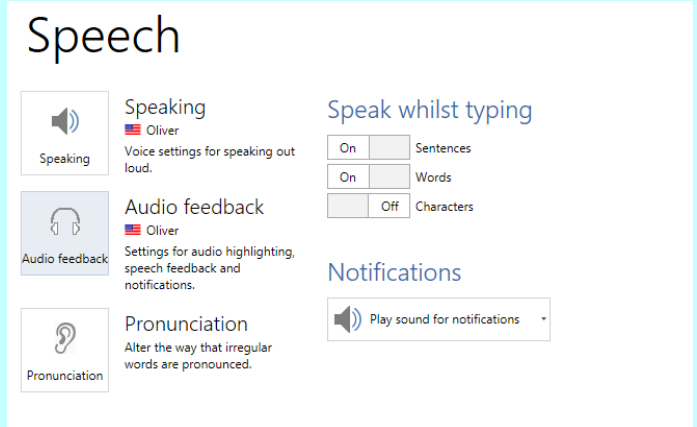


Click on the **Menu** bar, then **Settings**, and **Speech**.

Speaking

Choose your preferred voice for speaking out loud. You can adjust the pitch, speed and volume.

Click on **Test Speech** to preview your changes.



Audio feedback

Choose the voice for audio highlighting, speech feedback and notifications. Audio feedback can also be sent to a different speaker.

Speak while typing

Text in the writing area can automatically be spoken after each sentence, each word or each character. Just choose On or Off for each option.

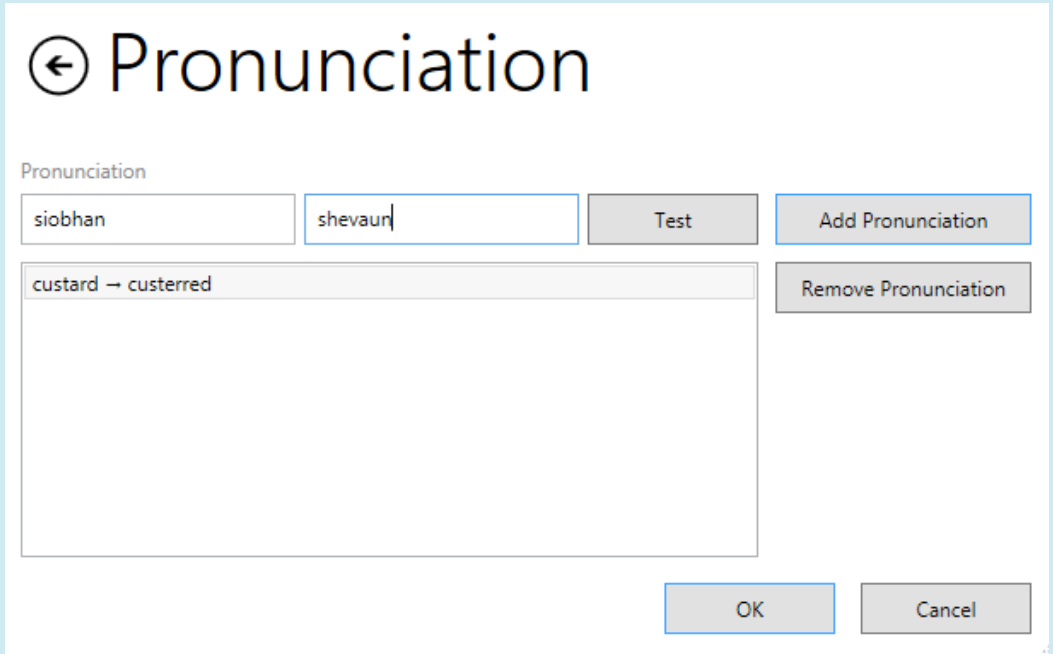
Notifications

Choose between no sound, sound only, or sound plus speech for notifications.

Settings

Pronunciation

If you find that a particular word is not being pronounced correctly, this can be corrected by clicking on **Pronunciation** in Speech Settings.

Repeat to add as many words to the list as required, and click **OK** when you have finished.
