I ______ (Contestant) Understand that horsemanship is the highest scoring category of the pageant.

I ______ (Contestant) Understand that the minimum score requirement still stands even if I am the only participant in the age group.

We have a minimum score requirement to be sure that any contestant that wins a title of Miss Keystone State Rodeo is fully ready for the title she will hold. It is to be sure that her horsemanship, rodeo knowledge and grace is at the level she would need in order to be a successful rodeo queen. The Miss Keystone State Rodeo Organization will release copies via email to all contestants to review to see where they excelled and where they might have lacked. The MKSR Board of directors encourages any young lady who may not win her first time competing to come back again! We host an annual clinic to help contestants learn and grow into a rodeo queen!
