

Things to Keep in Mind While Sizing :

All of our rings come in quarter sizes.

Remember that finger sizes fluctuate! Fingers shrink or expand based on temperature.

Wider rings tend to fit tighter - we recommend sizing up a quarter or half size for a more comfortable fit.

Eternity style rings cannot be resized, so please make sure you are confident with your size before ordering.

We highly recommend visiting us in store or going to your local jeweler to get sized. If you are unable, you can also order our free at home Ring Sizer.

Measure a Current Ring

Print this guide on 8.5x11" paper with the page scaling set to 100%.

Select a ring that fits properly on the intended finger.

Lay the ring over the size circles until you are able to match the inside edge of the ring to one of the circles.

If the ring falls between two sizes, we recommend ordering the larger size or the quarter size in between.
