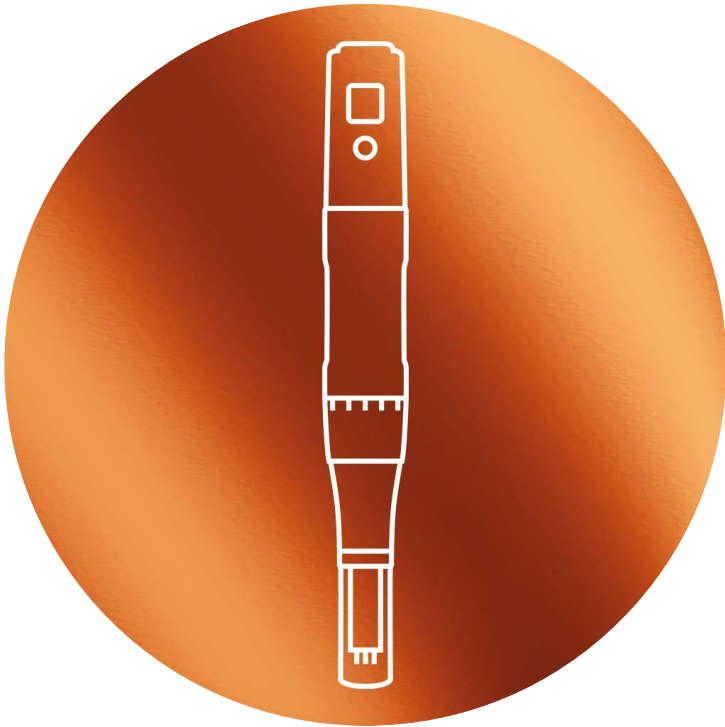

# MICRONEEDLE MESOTHERAPY

It is a method involving the use of a device equipped with very fine needles, e.g. a pen or derma roller, to mechanically puncture the skin. Micro-punctures in the skin create micro-channels, allowing active substances to penetrate deep into the skin. In addition, producing controlled skin damage triggers an inflammatory response, releasing growth factors that stimulate fibroblast activity. This process results in increased synthesis of collagen, elastin and glucosamine. It helps restore firmness and density in the skin structure.

The key to ensure treatment effectiveness is to select the right active substances for the patient's skin problem.

## MICRO-NEEDLE MESOTHERAPY MECHANISM

Controlled micro-damage to the skin through targeted puncturing

Growth factors intensify and stimulate restoration and complete remodelling processes by stimulating type III collagen production

# VENOME PEN

It is a device used in microneedle mesotherapy, equipped with three types of cartridges with 11, 24 and 36 needles arranged in a row. The Venome Pen has one of the highest puncture rates on the market of up to 22,000 punctures per minute, so the treatment can be carried out in a shorter time for the full effect of the procedure.

A variable needle extension range of 0.25-2.5 mm allows full control of injection depth. In addition, the Venome Pen has two rechargeable batteries that allow 8 hours of wireless operation.

The pen can be used for microneedle mesotherapy to make punctures at an even depth, so that the active substances will be evenly delivered to the skin; another advantage of the device is that the tip can be changed to a smaller number of needles, which makes it possible to reach hard to access areas such as the nose, eye area and mouth.

## STIMULATE RANGE

These are products that stimulate the production of protein fibres including collagen and elastin, with anti-wrinkle properties. The products ensure deep moisturisation, restoring a healthy appearance to the skin.

### VENOME STIMULATE COLLAGEN

Venome Collagen is a unique combination of active substances such as tetrapeptide-2, hydrolysed collagen and sodium hyaluronate. The product helps reduce wrinkles and scars by properly moisturising the skin and improving its texture.



To achieve full results, 4-6 treatments should be performed in a series at a frequency of every 14 days.

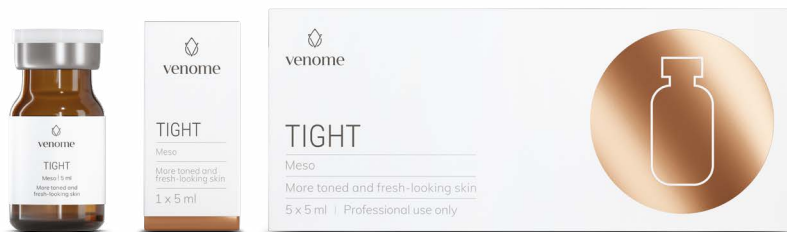
