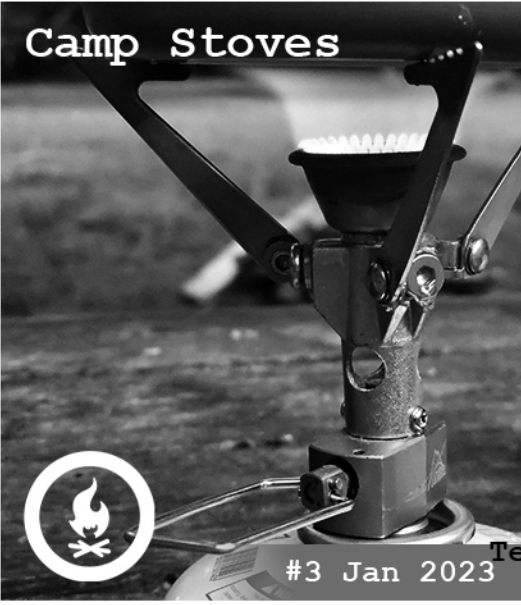

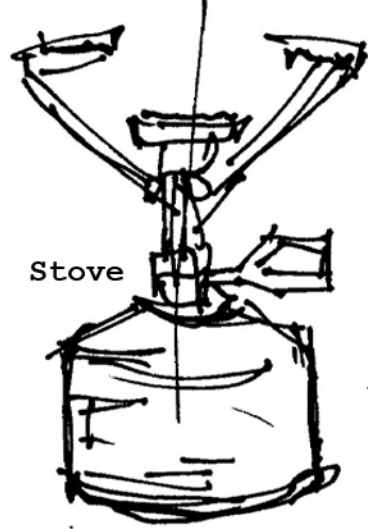
## Camp Stoves

## Fuel Canister

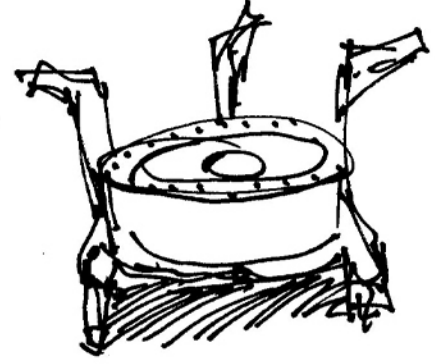
Pros: size, weight, self-sealing, burns hot, flame adjustment



Cons: cost, disposal can't fly with, cold weather issues, loud

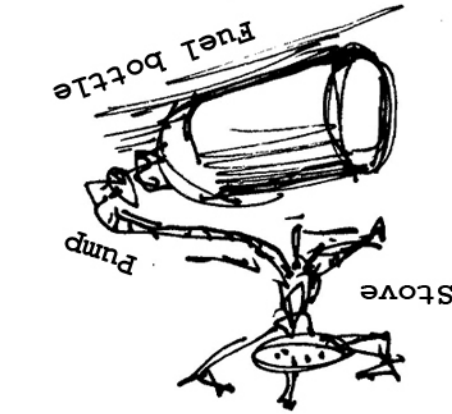
## Alcohol Stoves

Pros: simple stoves, denatured alcohol is cheap, quiet



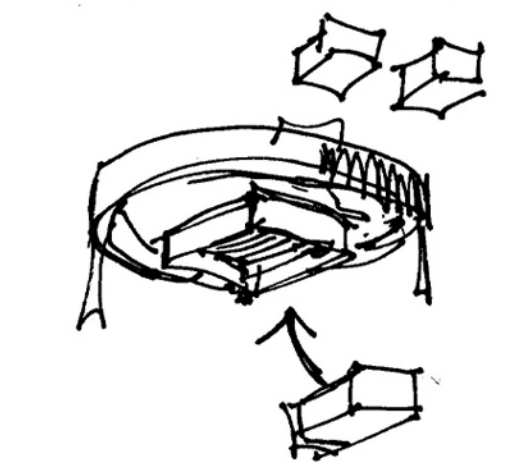
Cons: needs windscreen, not as hot as canister, spill risk, invisible flame, fuel availability

Cons: high cost, maintenance and cleaning, heavy, fuel spill risk



Pros: stable base, reusable bottle, multiple fuels, high temp, good in cold/high altitude

Cons: smell, residue, longer heating time, lower temp



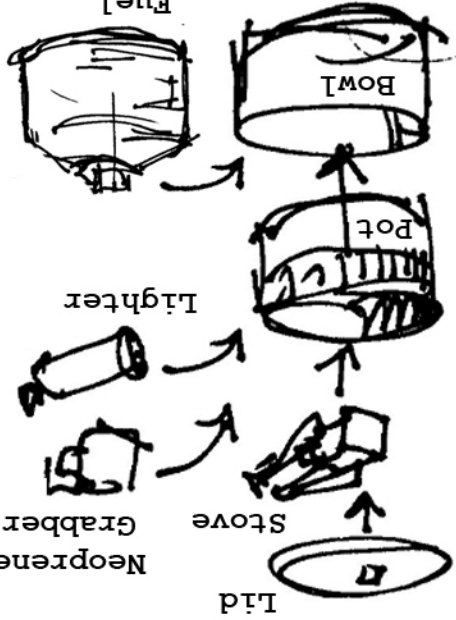
Pros: lightweight, cheap, easy to light, reusable, can travel with

Cons: need dry fuel, may be banned in areas with fire risk



Pros: simple and lightweight, easily gathered fuel source
