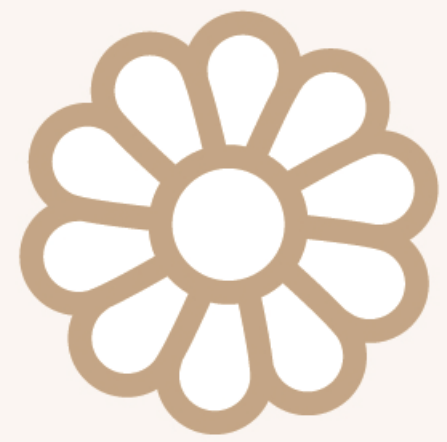

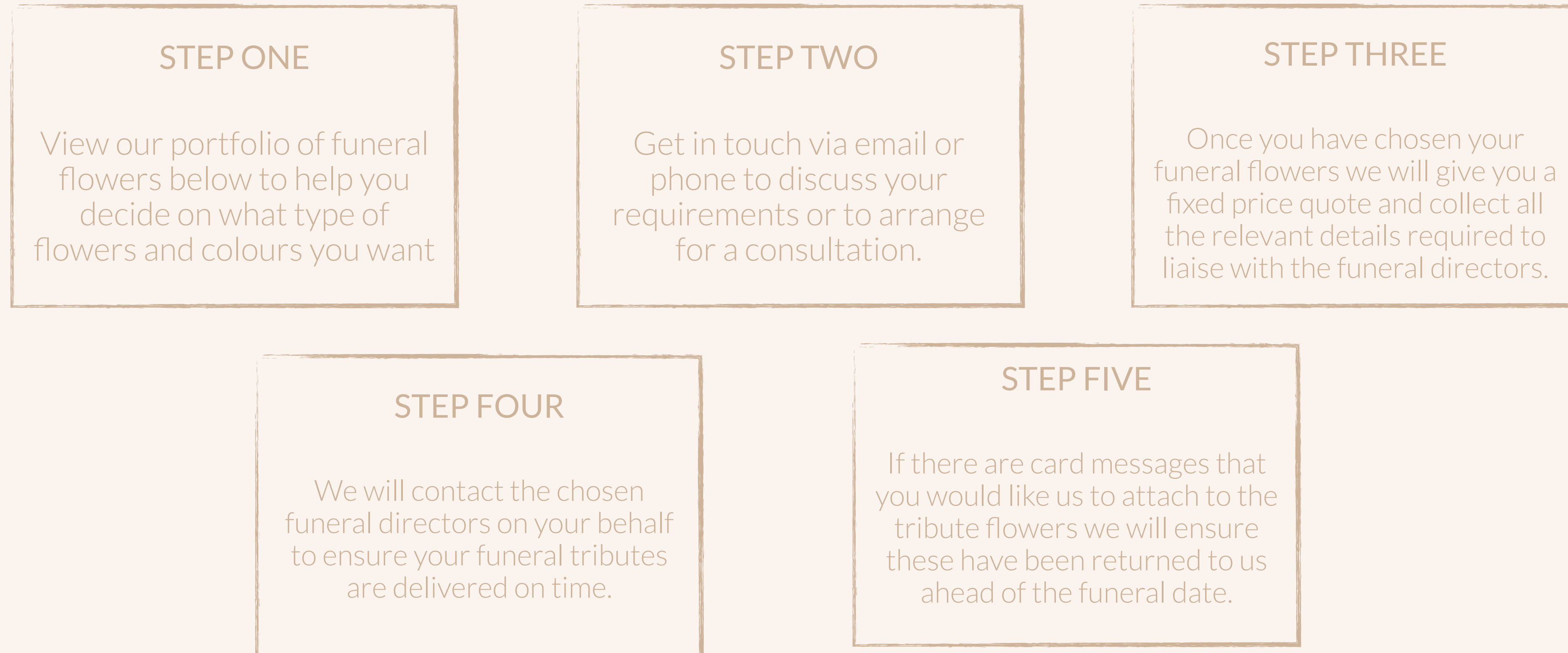
About Us

Flower colours and their significance

Green and white

White flowers convey a sense of peace and tranquility whereas green is the colour of nature, and can represent the natural cycle of life. When combined, green and white funeral flowers create a harmonious and peaceful effect.

Pastel colours

When combined in a floral arrangement, pastel colours create a gentle and comforting aesthetic. The use of light pink, lavender, and cream flowers bring a sense of beauty and solace to an arrangement.

Red roses

While red roses may be associated with romantic love, their use in funeral flowers is more about expressing profound emotions, respect, and the enduring legacy of the person who has passed away.

Blue, yellow and white

Blue for calmness and spirituality, yellow for positivity and happiness and white for peace and sympathy.

When combined, the blue, yellow, and white colour palette creates a harmonious and soothing arrangement that honours the memory of the deceased while offering comfort to those mourning.

Bright and colourful

Bright colours are associated with optimism and hope. Using a variety of vibrant colours can represent the diverse and dynamic aspects of the person's character. Colourful flowers can evoke memories of happy times and shared laughter, emphasising the joyful moments rather than the sadness of loss.

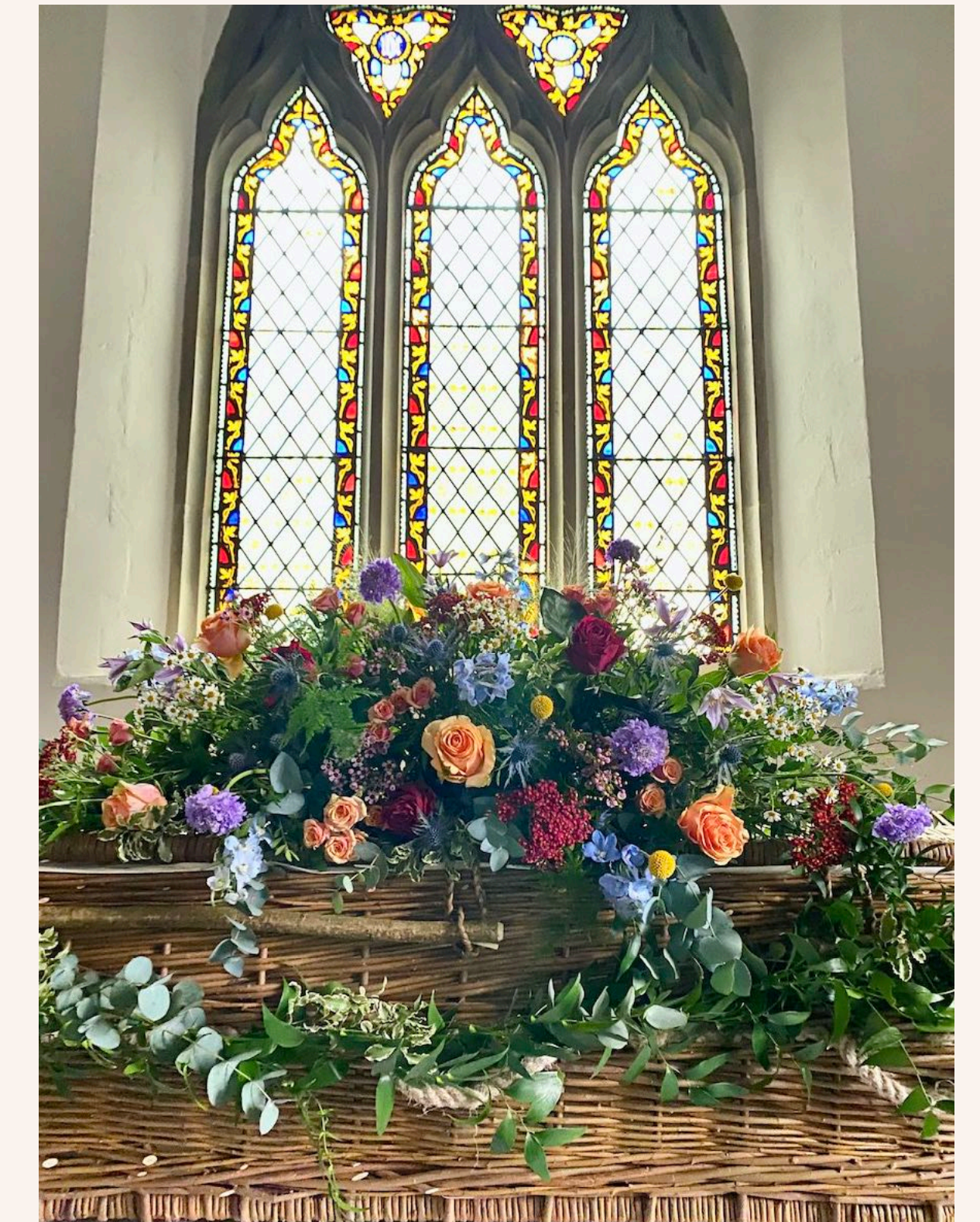
