Parent/Player Code of Conduct

PLAYERS:

- I will remember that playing lacrosse is an opportunity to learn and have fun.
- I will concentrate, train and play lacrosse to the best of my abilities, always giving my best effort.
- I will do my best to be a true team player, remembering that all players have strengths and weaknesses, the same as I do.
- I will learn and play by the rules of lacrosse at all times, honouring the history of sportsmanship.
- I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will listen and accept their decisions and show them respect.
- I will treat my teammates, coaches, opposing players and coaches, officials and fans with respect at all times, and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will refrain from use of profanity, obscenities or derogatory comments to any players, coaches, officials and fans.
- I will control my temper, resisting the temptation to retaliate and will exercise self-control.
- While at home or traveling, I will conduct myself in a professional manner that reflects my team and association's values.
- I will respect all fields/facilities and understand that it is a privilege to play in the facilities provided.

PARENTS:

- I will always be positive.
- I will allow the coaches to coach. I will not approach and/or give direction to any players during a game or practice.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and game officials.
- I will place the physical and emotional well-being of all players ahead of any desire to win.
- I will not criticize game officials and recognize that they are being developed in the same manner as the players.
- I will refrain from the use of profanity, obscenities or derogatory comments to players, coaches, referees and fans.
- If I have a concern or a problem with the coach or the association, I will contact the coach at least 24 hours afterwards to set up an appropriate time to address these issues. I will not bring up concerns or problems during or after a game or practice.
