STEP 3

Competitive Introduction Coaching Clinic (Certification)



Requirements to Complete

1. Receive a successful practice evaluation (either in-person or submitted video) by a certified coaching supervision through the OLA or an equivalent Member Association
2. Maintain certification by accumulating at least twenty (20) Professional Development Points every five years
3. Complete The Making Ethical Decisions online training module (Required)

LEVEL 3

Required for:

All OLA coaches attending a Lacrosse Canada (LC) National or World Lacrosse (WL) International Championship Event
