### **Fingering Charts**

The following fingering charts show different scales that can be played on your Pocket Flute. It's important to note that these charts are not needed to enjoy playing music on your flute. In many cultures people never learn music theory, they simply "play by ear". That said, when you find you have hit a plateau in your playing, try learning a new scale, it will add whole new dimensions to your songs.

### **Reading the Charts**

The black dots indicate closed holes and the tapered end of the drawing indicates the mouthpiece. Under each diagram is the corresponding note. Please remember that with all wind instruments the amount of air pressure exerted will determine the accuracy of the note, more pressure will sharpen the note, while less pressure will flatten it.
