

RULES OF PLAY 50/50 ELETRONIC RAFFLE

- 1. The lottery will take place online via www.NiagaraHealthLottery.com and using a handheld device located in the St. Catharines Niagara Health Foundation office from Monday, July 3rd, 2023 Thursday, May 2nd, 2024. Dates are outlined in line #9.
- 2. Only 18 years or older are eligible to purchase tickets.
- 3. Must be in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase.
- 4. Tickets are 3 for \$10 / 40 for \$20 / 200 for \$50 / 400 for \$75.
- 5. Tickets will be available online at www.NiagaraHealthLottery.com
- 6. Tickets will be sold using an electronic raffle system supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
- 7. After purchasing the online tickets, patrons will receive a confirmation email from a Random Selection System with their 50/50 registered numbers. Ticket numbers are generated randomly, and therefore no special numbers maybe selected. If numbers do not arrive via email, please email Foundation@Niagarahealth.on.ca
- 8. A Random Number Generation (RNG) system will select the winning ticket number from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.
- 9. Outlined below are the ticket sale start and end dates and the Early Bird and Grand Prize dates.

- 10. The amount of the 50/50 will be **posted online at www.NiagaraHealthLottery.com.**
- 11. The winning number will be announced by email, posted on Facebook and Website at www.NiagaraHealthLottery.com
- 12. The winner may claim their prize by contacting Niagara Health Foundation at: (905) 323-3863 or by email at: Foundation@Niagarahealth.on.ca. The ticket may then be brought at Niagara Health Foundations at 1200 Fourth Avenue, St. Catharines, ON at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. The winner will then be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. All payments will be made by cheque.
- 13. The winning ticket holder has **6 months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchase for.
- 14. The winner must provide his/her name, address, and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet.
- 15. In our ongoing efforts to ensure the integrity of our lottery operations and maintain the confidence of Ontarians, the Niagara Health Foundation will publish the information and photo of the winner in all lottery wins of \$1,000 or more. This information will include the name, city of residence and the prize amount won for all individuals or groups who are paid a lottery prize of \$1,000 or more.
- 16. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
- 17. In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning stub will kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity other than Niagara Health Foundation, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
- 18. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws: Niagara Health Foundation staff, Volunteers, Board Members, and anyone living in the same households of those individuals.
