

Sandra Banholzer named CEO of the Year at the 2024 SEF. Women Award ceremony.

The fourth SEF.WomenAward was presented at a gala evening in Zurich on 8 March 2024. The prize recognises outstanding performance by women in business and is awarded in the categories of Young Entrepreneur of the Year and Entrepreneur/CEO of the Year. An award honouring the life's work of an exceptional businesswoman is also presented.

This year's winners were Alessia Schrepfer, WeNurse AG, who was named "Young Entrepreneur of the Year", and Sandra Banholzer, RAUSCH AG KREUZLINGEN, named "Entrepreneur/CEO of the Year". Barbara Kux was the recipient of the honorary award.

The Swiss Economic Forum (SEF) recognised these three women for their outstanding entrepreneurial track records.
