# MODE



P: Program AE

**Tv**: Shutter-priority AE

**Av** : Aperture-priority AE


M : Manual exposure

Turn the Mode Dial while holding down the Mode Dial center (Mode Dial lock release button).

# **APERTURE SETTING / F-STOP**



Set the Mode Dial to Av.




While looking at the LCD panel, turn the Main Dial <€□ > to set the desired aperture.

Focus the subject and press the shutter button halfway. The shutter speed is set automatically.




Check the viewfinder. As long as the shutter speed is not blinking, you can take your photo.

# ISO




Press the ISO button on the top of the camera.



While looking at the LCD panel or through the viewfinder, turn the Main Dial and selected your desired ISO setting.

# **FOCUS MODE**



Set the lens focus mode switch to AF.



Press the AF button.




Select the AF operation by turning the main dial or the Quick Control Dial to the desired AF setting.



# **FOCUS POINT**




Press the AF Point Selection button ( ).

Select an AF point.


The AF point selection will change in the direction you tilt the  $< \xi^{\uparrow} >$ . If you press SET, the center AF point (or center zone) will be selected.


You can also select a horizontal AF point by turning the Main Dial and select a vertical AF point by turning the Quick Control Dial

# CONTINUOUS SHOOTING MODE




Press the DRIVE button.

Press the DRIVE button.


While looking at the LCD panel, turn the Quick Control Dial < > to select the self-timer delay.

You can check the self-timer operation with the self-timer lamp, beeper and countdown display on the LCD panel.

Two seconds before the picture is taken, the self-timer lamp will light up and the beeper will sound faster.


### **EXPOSURE COMPENSATION**






While looking at the viewfinder or LCD panel, turn the Quick Control Dial < >.
